As you are aware that the Mid Day Meal Scheme(MDMS) is a very important flagship program implemented in 11.40 lakh schools across the country covering 12 crore children (enrolment). The use of Aadhaar for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly to them in a convenient and seamless manner and Aadhaar obviates the need for producing multiple documents to prove one's identity.

- 2. Based on the notifications issued in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar Act 2016, letters of Joint Secretary and Secretary, Department of School Education and Literacy, MHRD were sent vide which it was desired to take necessary action so that 100% Aadhaar enrolment of students can be achieved.
- 3. A robust MIS with school wise details of students without Aadhaar numbers may be prepared for effective monitoring and review. I am sure that regular review at your level, at least once in a fortnight, will go a long way in implementing the scheme in a transparent and better way. Further, you are also requested to share the status of Aadhaar enrolment of children in the attached format.
