In an important Inter-Ministerial synergy, the Ministry of Tourism has decided to support a programme for the training of cook-cum-helpers engaged in the Mid Day Meal Scheme of the Ministry of Human Resource Development. The support will be in terms of the Guidelines enclosed (Annexure I).

- 2. It will be mandatory for the Institutes mentioned in the list at Annexure II to organise the training courses on being approached by the Ministry of Human Resource Development.
- 3. The Ministry of Human Resource Development will communicate nominations for the training courses to the Institutes concerned directly under intimation to the Programme Monitoring Unit Skill Development, Ministry of Tourism.
- 4. The Institute of Hotel Management, PUSA will develop the training module as required in point (9) of the Guideline and communicate the same to the listed Institutes, as also to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, latest by 15/05/2013.
- 5.. As will be noted, the Ministry of Tourism will meet the cost of the training programme in terms of point (13) of the Guidelines. The Institutes are advised to prefer their respective claims for reimbursement from time to time. Each claim will have to be supported by a statement of itemized expenditure certified by the Principal.
- 6. The Institutes will send, in the first week of each month, a report indicating the progress specific to this programme. The reports, duly signed, should be e-mailed at : pmuhsrt@gmail.com
- 7. The Ministry of Human Resource Development will send half-yearly reports to the Ministry of Tourism as to the impact of this training programme.

A programme of training for cook-cum-helpers engaged in the Mid Day Meal Scheme -

GUIDELINES

(1) Objective

The Mid Day Meal Scheme, the largest of its kind, needs to be delivered with standards that are universally acceptable. The workforce managing the Scheme, especially the cooks and helpers must, therefore, be informed of cooking varieties and methods, of the nutritional aspects of a meal, and of the hygiene that must attend the entire delivery chain. This calls for bringing up resource persons from amongst the existing service providers, who are trained to have theses abilities and who, in turn, will serve as motivators and masters for others. The objective of the training Programme will be to raise, gradually, the Scheme standards.

(2) Implementation

- (i) The Programme will be implemented by the Ministry of Tourism (MoT) in partnership with the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education and Literacy (MHRD). However, the actual training will be delivered by the Institutes of Hotel Management (IHMs) and the Food Craft Institutes (FCIs) designated by MoT for the purpose.
- (ii) The following will be the authorities for implementation :
 - a. The Joint Secretary, Elementary Education MHRD, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi

For making nominations to the training courses and the matters connected therewith.

- The Programme Monitoring Unit Skill Development, MoT
 For processing financial sanctions and monitoring the Programme including issuing clarifications on administrative aspects.
- c. The Principals of the designated IHMs and FCIs, for the conduct of training programmes and certification.

d. Consultant (Academic), NCHMCT for clarifying issues / doubts relating to course contents.

(3) Target Group

Persons engaged in the Mid Day Meal Scheme as cook-cum-helpers.

(4) Course offered

A ten day full time course (9 a.m to 5 p.m) covering the following, amongst others :

- Knowledge dissemination regarding the calorific and nutritive values of Mid Day Meal.
- ii) Methods of cooking for retaining the nutritive value of cooking ingredients.
- iii) Awareness regarding issues of malnutrition and also benchmark of nutrition.
- iv) Importance of Hand washing.
- v) General health and Hygienic practices and concerns.
- vi) Communication skill

(5) Intake

Effort will be to nominate 30 students for a training course. However, in no circumstance a course with less than 15 students will be conducted.

(6) Selection

MHRD will ensure that persons nominated are at least 8th class pass. Efforts, however, will be to pick up those who could, with training, serve as trainers for others.

(7) Course frequency

MHRD will make effort to nominate as many persons as possible during school vacations. The provisional target for FY 2013-14 will be to nominate 600 persons.

(8) Fee

No Application fee chargeable to the trainee.

(9) Course contents

The training module covering the 6 areas mentioned will be developed by IHM PUSA in consultation with MHRD, also taking inputs from the Principals of IHMs at Lajpat Nagar and Chandigarh, as also the Consultant Academic in NCHMCT.

(10) Lunch

IHMs / FCIs will provide lunch to the trainees @ Rs. 70 per day per trainee.

(11) Certification

The trainees with minimum attendance of 90 per cent will be required to appear in an end of the course test and those who pass successfully will be awarded joint certificate of MHRD and IHMs / FCIs. For the purpose of this test, there will be one internal and one external examiner – the latter will be drawn from a panel of experts maintained by NCHMCT.

(12) Pass-out / placement Records

MHRD, as also IHMs / FCIs concerned, will put the names of passouts, together with their contact addresses, on their websites.

(13) Funding of the Programme / Assistance to IHMs/FCIs (Provisional)

MoT will pay the following assistance to IHMs / FCIs per trainee :
