**Subject: Allocation of free foodgrains to States/UTs under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for the balance 3 Quarters of financial year 2009-10 (July, 2009 to March, 2010)**

On the basis of concurrence received from the Department of Food & Public Distribution vide their O.M. No. 4-3/2009-BP-II dated 15.7.2009, final allocation of foodgrains to States/UTs under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for the last 3 Quarters of 2009-10 (July, 2009 to March, 2010), after taking into account the annual allocation of foodgrains for 2009-10, ad-hoc allocation made by this Department vide order of even number dated 18.3.2009 and the unspent stock of foodgrains as on 31.3.2009 as indicated by States/UTs, is being made as per the Enclosure-I.

2. States/UTs are required to further allocate the foodgrains to the districts as per the requirement under the provision of MDM Guidelines under intimation to this Department as well as to Food Corporation of India (FCI) for supply of foodgrains accordingly.
3. As per the stipulation made by the Department of Food & Public Distribution in the OM mentioned above, the validity period of lifting of foodgrains for the month of July, 2009 will be upto 31.8.2009. As for subsequent months, lifting period of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines.
3. As per the extant guidelines issued by Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt. of India vide their letter No. 1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.9.2008, allocated foodgrains can be lifted from the FCI godowns starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25<sup>th</sup> of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts officers are, therefore, required to be directed to lift the foodgrains accordingly. Payment of the cost of foodgrains will be made centrally by Govt. of India on receiving the state-wise consolidated bills from the FCI Headquarter.
4. The entire quantity of the allocated foodgrains to Lakshadweep for current year 2009-10 may be lifted by the UT Administration in full during September/October, 2009 at their convenience.
4. As per para 3.7 of MDM Guidelines, the foodgrains to be supplied by FCI should be of best available quality, which in any case, will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ). State/UT Governments are requested to instruct the officer responsible for lifting from FCI godown to ensure that foodgrains received from FCI is of atleast FAQ. Records regarding quality ensurance should be maintained at the district level and the FCI godown.

Subject:- Allocation of food grains under Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDM) for the year 2009-10 ( 1.07.2009 to 31.03.2010) - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to O.M. No F-5-1/2009-Desk(MDM) dated 18.06.2009 and 02.07.2009 and D.O. letter No. 4-3/2009-EE-5 (MDM 1-2) dated 16.6.2009 of Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development, on the above subject and to convey the approval of this Department for allocation of 14,77,728 tons of rice and 3,58,957 tons of wheat in respect of 27 States for the balance period (July 2009 to March, 2010) for the year 2009-10 at Central Issue Price (CIP) applicable for the Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under the Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDM) scheme.

2. The validity period of lifting of foodgrains and depositing the cost of foodgrains for the month of July, 2009 will be up to 31.8.2009. As for subsequent months lifting period and deposit of cost will as per extant guidelines.

3. It may be ensured that this allocation of food grains is utilized to the maximum possible extent so that the beneficiaries get full benefit of the Scheme. Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy may issue State-wise allocation of this quantity of food grains to FCI and ensure its lifting within the year 2009-10 under intimation to this Department.

4. Food Corporation of India (FCI) would issue rice and wheat as per State-wise allocation for the year 2009-10 with monthly breakup to be made by the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development. Payment of bills to FCI for the quantities lifted shall be made by the concerned State Governments/Human Resource Development Ministry within 15 days of presentation of the bills.

5. Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy is also requested to furnish consolidated Utilization Certificate for the food grains allocated to them under Mid Day Meal Scheme MDM for the year 2008-09 which is already due and for the current year 2009-10 at the end of the current year.

6. Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development may ensure that FCI gets full payment in respect of food grains released by it to States/UTs under the Scheme & utilization certificates are furnished by the State/UT Governments to it on time. They are also requested to make payment of outstanding amounts to FCI without any delay, as they would be bearing huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount.

7. The Ministry of Human Resource Development are also informed that the entire quantity of the allocated foodgrains to Lakshadweep for current year 2009-10 may be lifted by the UT Administration in full during September/October at their convenience.

8. This issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. No.1937/FA dated 14.07.2009.







In continuation of this Department's Allocation Order of even number dated 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2009 and 6<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 allocating foodgrains for 27 States/UTs and for 3 States respectively for the last 3 Quarters of 2009-10 (July, 2009 to March, 2010) and on the basis of concurrence received from the Department of Food & Public Distribution vide their O.M. No. 4-3/2009-BP-II dated 12.08.2009, final allocation of foodgrains to 4 more States viz.
