Subject: Allocation of food grains to States/UTs under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for the 3rd Quarter (October to December, 2016) and 4th Quarter (January, 2017 to March, 2017) and 12 drought affected States for financial year 2016-17.

The Department of Food & Public Distribution has approved the allocation of 1374479.59 MTs of food grains comprising 213330.29 MTs wheat and 1161149.30 MTs rice for the 3rd and 4th Quarter of 2016-17 (October 2016 to March, 2017) to this Ministry for allocation to various States/UTs at NFSA prices i.e. Rs. 2 per kg of wheat and Rs. 3 per kg of rice under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS). Accordingly, the undersigned is directed to convey the allocation of food grains to States/UTs under MDMS for the 3rd Quarter (October to December, 2016) and 4th Quarter (January, 2017 to March, 2017) and 12 drought affected States during 2016-17 as per the Annexure-I, Annexure-II and Annexure-III respectively.

2. States/UTs are required to further allocate the food grains to the districts as per their requirement under the provisions of MDM Guidelines and under intimation to this Department as well as Food Corporation of India (FCI) for supply of food grains accordingly.

3. District Administration on receiving the allocation from the State/UT will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of food grains to the local FCI depot depending upon its requirement, transportation convenience and storage capacity.

4. District can lift food grains on monthly, bi-monthly or quarterly basis as indicated in its schedule. However, as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt. of India vide their letter No. 1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.9.2008, allocated food grains can be lifted from the FCI godowns starting from the 1st day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25th of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts Officers may, therefore, be directed to lift the food grains accordingly.

5. Payment of the cost of food grains will be made by District authorities within 20 days of the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by this Department vide letter No. 1-15/2009- Desk(MDM) dated 10.2.2010. The guidelines for decentralization of payment of cost of food grains to FCI at district level can be downloaded from the website of this Department www.mdm.nic.in *Payments of outstanding bills may also be made to FCI without any delay as FCI bears huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount. It is advised that the bills of FCI may be paid through e-payment to avoid the delay.*

6. Procedure laid down in para 3.6 to 3.9 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 10.2.2010 on decentralization of payment of cost of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that best quality of food grains, which in any case, will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ) is lifted from FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI depots should be repeated at each level till the food grains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality of food grains is delivered for consumption by children. Records/samples regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.

7. It is stated that the foodgrains for 12 drought affected States viz. Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand as mentioned in Annexure-III is on the basis of the PAB-MDM approval. Now the summer vacations are over and concerned States have utilized the foodgrains for drought affected areas from the foodgrains already allocated for the first two quarters of 2016-17 as per the number of children and working days actually covered. Therefore, only actual utilized quantity of foodgrains for drought should be lifted by the concerned States during the 3rd quarter.

8. As per para 5.4 of MDM Guidelines, a monthly report on off take, payment and quantity of food grains sent to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format latest by 15th of the following month on regular basis.

Subject:- Allocation of food grains under Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDM) for the year 2016-17 for the period 1.10.2016 to 31.03.2017 - reg.

In continuation of this Department's O.M. of even number dated 01.04.2016 and in pursuance of O.M. No. 5-1/2016-Desk (MDM) dated 10.08.2016 of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of school Education & Literacy on the above mentioned subject, the undersigned is directed to convey the approval of this Department for allocation of 1374479.59 tons of food grains comprising 213330.30 tons of Wheat & 1161149.29 tons of rice for 3rd and 4th quarters of 2016-17 (October, 2016 to the March, 2017) to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of school Education & Literacy at NFSA prices i.e. Rs. 2 per kg of wheat and Rs. 3 per kg of rice, under the Mid Day Meal (MDM) Scheme.

2. The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines.
3. The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy may communicate State-wise/UT-wise allocation of the allocated quantity of foodgrains to FCI and States/UTs well in time and ensure its lifting within the stipulated validity period by States/UTs.
4. Food Corporation of India (FCI) would issue rice and wheat as per State/UT-wise allocation for the year 2016-17 with monthly breakup to be made by the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development.
5. The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy is also requested to furnish the consolidated Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma GFR - 19A duly signed by the concerned Director for the foodgrains allocated to them under Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDM) for the year 2016-17 at the end of the current financial year.
6. The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development may ensure that FCI gets full payment in respect of food grains released by it to States/UTs under the Scheme & utilization certificates are furnished by the State/UT Governments to it in time. They are also requested to make payment of outstanding amounts to FCI without any delay, as FCI bears huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount.
