**Subject: Allocation of foodgrains to States/UTs under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) Scheme in schools for the 1st Quarter (April, 2023 to June, 2023) and 2nd Quarter (July, 2023 to September, 2023) for financial year 2023-24 -reg.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to forward the Department of Food & Public Distribution (D/o F&PD)'s O.M. Nos. 4-2/2022-BP-II (e-379501) dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the concurrence of the Department of Food & Public Distribution for allocation of **1399796.04 MTs of foodgrains, consisting of 232312.88 MTs of wheat and 1167483.16 MTs of fortified rice for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of F.Y. 2023-24 i.e. 01.04.2023 to 30.09.2023** at National Food Security Act (NFSA) prices i.e. Rs.2.00 per kg of wheat and Rs.3.00 per kg of rice under PM POSHAN Scheme. The allocation of foodgrains to States & UTs during **1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of F.Y 2023-24 is enclosed at Annexure-I and Annexure-II** respectively.

2. The State is requested to further allocate the foodgrains to the Districts as per their requirement on the basis of approved number of children and working days under intimation to this Department as well as to the Food Corporation of India (FCI) for supply of foodgrains accordingly.

3. After receiving foodgrains allocation from the State, the District Administration will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of foodgrains to the local FCI depot depending upon its requirement, transportation convenience and storage capacity. **The validity period for lifting of foodgrains for the month of April, 2023 will be upto 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 and for the subsequent months, the validity period for depositing of cost and lifting of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines.**

4. District Administration may lift allocated food grains on monthly, bi-monthly or quarterly basis as indicated in its schedule, in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Department of Food & Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Govt. of India vide their letter No. 1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.09.2008, from the FCI godowns starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25<sup>th</sup> of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts officers are, therefore, required to be directed to lift the food grains accordingly.

5. Payment of the cost of foodgrains will be made by District Authorities within 20 days of the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by this Department vide letter No. 1-3/2022-Desk(PM POSHAN) dated 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.

6. Procedure laid down in para 5.5 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2022 on payment of cost of foodgrains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality foodgrains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ), is lifted from the FCI godowns. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI depots should be repeated at each level till the foodgrains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality food grains are delivered for consumption by children. Records/samples to ensure quality should be maintained at all levels.

7. As per para 5.6(ii) of the above mentioned guidelines dated 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2022, a monthly report on payment to FCI and quantity of foodgrains lifted and released to Schools/Cooking Agency may be furnished in the prescribed format (**Annexure-III**) latest by 15<sup>th</sup> of each following month strictly on regular basis. The Monthly Progress Report (MPR) may also be emailed on monthly basis.

8. The States & UTs will furnish Utilization Certificate of the foodgrains supplied under the Scheme during the year 2022-23 latest by 30.06.2023 in the format enclosed at **Annexure-IV** to enable GOI to release allocation of food grains for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter before 1<sup>st</sup> week of August, 2023. In the Utilization Certificate, only the quantity actually consumed at the Schools/Cooking agency level will be indicated as utilized. Whatever remains in Schools/ Cooking Agency / Block/ District level stores/ godowns will be shown as unspent balance.


2. The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.

3. The Department of School Education & Literacy may communicate State/UT-wise allocation of the allocated quantity of foodgrains to FCI and States/UTs well in time and ensure its lifting within the stipulated validity period by States/UTs.

4. Food Corporation of India (FCI) would issue rice and wheat as per State-wise allocation for the year 2023-24 with monthly breakup to be made by the Department of School Education and Literacy.

5. The Department of School Education & Literacy is also requested to furnish consolidated Utilization Certificate duly signed by the concerned DS/Director for the foodgrains allocated to them under PM POSHAN Scheme for the year 2022-23.

6. The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education may ensure that FCI gets full payment in respect of foodgrains released by it to States/UTs under the Scheme & utilization certificates are furnished by the State/UT Governments to it in time. They are also requested to make payment of outstanding amounts to FCI without any delays as FCI bears huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount.
