

You may be aware that the Indian Dairy sector is presently experiencing unprecedented crisis in disposal of surplus milk production and thereby ensuring regular payments to the farmers. Higher growth in milk production coupled with low export opportunity has resulted in piling up of huge stock of Skimmed milk powder and white butter. This coupled with the constraints of increasing domestic sale in a short period of time has aggravated the distress faced by the farmers.

- 2017 and 15th June 2018 to include milk & milk products in the recipe of food basket used to supply to schools under Mid-day meal programme. This Department also took up the matter with Chief Secretaries of all States on 15th December 2017 and requested to supply milk and milk products through school network under Mid-day meal programme. The states of Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Pondicherry, Rajasthan, Maharashtra and Gujarat have confirmed that they are supplying milk through school network.
- 3. You would agree that milk is a complete food and inclusion in the recipe of nutritional programme implemented by your ministry will go a long way not only address nutritional requirements of millions of children and lactating mothers, who face malnutrition but also in paying regular and remunerative prices to the 17 million cooperative farmers.
- 4. I would appreciate if your Department could issue necessary directives to all States/UTs to include milk & milk products from cooperative Milk unions/Federations through school network under Mid-day meal programme.

Subject:- Advisory to States regarding high availability of milk during flush season

The undersigned is directed to inform that the flush season of milk production is prevailing in most parts of the country. There are reports that due to the surplus availability of milk, the prices paid to the farmers have declined.

- 2. Inorder to tide over the situation, the State Governments are requested to provide milk packets as part of mid day meal and health schemes. Hot milk and rice with sugar or jiggery is a very nutritious low cost option and season friendly too. This will ensure the following:
 - i. Quality food in Mid Day Meal Scheme & health schemes
 - ii. Remunerative prices to milk farmers
 - iii. Support to rural income for thereby realizing the PM's vision of doubling farmers income.
- 3. This issued in the best interest of dairy farmers for necessary action. It is requested to arrange to appraise this Department on the action taken in this regard.

Dear Sir

You may be aware that the Indian Dairy sector is presently experiencing unprecedented crisis in disposal of surplus milk production and thereby ensuring regular payments to the farmers. Higher growth in milk production coupled with low export opportunity has resulted in piling up of huge stock of Skimmed Milk Powder and White butter. This coupled with the constraints of increasing domestic sale in a short period of time has aggravated the distress faced by the farmers.

- The issue was taken up with your Department in which my predecessor wrote a letter on 26th December 2017 to include milk and milk products in the recipe of food basket used to supply to schools under Mid-day meal programme. This Department also took up the matter with Chief Secretaries of all States on 15th December 2017 and requested to supply milk and milk products through school network under Mid-day meal programme. The States of Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, Pondicherry and Gujarat have confirmed that they are supplying milk through school network. But, some of the States with higher quantity of surplus stocks of milk powder like Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and Punjab are yet to make a decision in this regard.
- 3. You would agree that milk is a complete food and inclusion in the recipe of nutritional programme implemented by your Ministry will go a long way not only in paying regular and remunerative prices to the 17 million cooperative farmers but also to address nutritional requirements of millions of children who face malnutrition.
- I would appreciate if your Department could urgently issue necessary directives to all States/UTs to include milk and milk products from cooperative milk unions/federations through school network under Mid-day meal programme...


