## Dear Sir | Madam,

The National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools, popularly known as the Mid-Day Meal Scheme is one of the foremost rights based Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The scheme covers about 11.6 crore children enrolled in elementary Classes (I-VIII) in 11.34 lakh Government and aided Schools.

- 2. Under the extraordinary circumstances of COVID-19 outbreak to enable the children to meet their nutritional requirement and safe guard their immunity, the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India advised the States and UTs to provide pulses, oil etc. (equivalent to cooking cost) along with food grains as Food Security Allowance (FSA) to eligible children. It is heartening to note that during these challenging times States and UTs have played a very crucial role in manifesting the resolve of Ministry of Education to meet the nutritional requirement of children, though the schools are closed.
- 3. On normal working days meal is served to all the children present in schools. However, due to closure of schools, States and UTs have been providing Food Security Allowance to all the enrolled children, which is more than the existing approvals. It is pertinent to note here that there is a specific para in PAB-MDM minutes of all States and UTs which envisages that 'During the year, if it is noticed by the State Govt. / UT administration that more funds are needed to implement the Mid Day Meal Scheme. due to increase in the attendance of children, increase in school working days or for any other reason, they may approach Government of India at any time during the year with justification seeking additional Central Assistance and food grains.
- 4. In this context, you are requested to review the requirement of funds and food grains for the whole year i.e. upto 31st March, 2021, vis-à-vis PAB-MDM approvals, and if required, submit proposals in the prescribed formats (Annexure - I & II) for additional funds and food grains along with appropriate justification latest by 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.
