*Respected Madam/Sir,*

As you are aware, this Department has created a dedicated portal for capturing MIS Data for PM POSHAN Scheme ([www.pmposhan.education.gov.in](http://www.pmposhan.education.gov.in)). Broadly the portal captures following data:

- i. Enrolment details
  - ii. Funds Transfer from State to Districts/ District to schools on monthly basis,
  - iii. Expenditure incurred (both in-kind/ in cash) on Monthly basis,
  - iv. No. of meal served (Unit of Measurement), number of Aadhar-seeded enrolment etc.,
  - v. Savings, if any due to deletion of duplication.
2. The MIS data captured in the portal is utilized for day-to-day monitoring and implementation of PM Poshan Scheme including funds flow. It is also shared with DBT Bharat Mission, Cabinet Secretariat.
3. It has been our experience that State Government/UT Administration and their District Administration are not uploading their data on the MIS portal on a regular basis. The lack of data has been a hindrance in effective monitoring of the Scheme and has been adversely commented upon by DBT Bharat Mission. The status of availability of data in the MIS Portal is enclosed herewith (a) Aadhar Seeded Enrolment at **(Annexure –I)**; b) District wise DBT Monthly data entry status for FY-2021-22 and FY-2022-23 at **(Annexure –II)**.
4. I would, therefore, request that you may like to appropriately direct the concerned officers to upload the data on PM Poshan MIS Portal without fail by 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. While furnishing data, it may be ensured that data integrity for Enrolment and Aadhar Seeded Enrolment is strictly maintained. It is further requested that pending District wise Aadhaar Authenticated / Seeded Enrolment Data may be uploaded into PM POSHAN MIS for both FY-2021-22 and FY-2022-23 (up to October, 2022) by 30-11-2022.
5. You may also recall that this Department has advised creation of DBT Cell both at State and District level with adequate manpower for time bound reporting of data vide our letter dated. 25-06-2016 (Copy at Annexure – III). I would be grateful for appropriate follow up action in the matter, if not taken already.


As you are aware, Aadhaar based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is a major governance reform initiative of the Government to ensure targeted delivery of benefits and series, ensuring greater transparency and accountability in public services delivery through effective use of technology. Progress of DBT is being monitored regularly at the highest level and progress report is to be sent on monthly basis.

2. DBT mission in number of meetings has informed the Department of School Education & Literacy that in the monthly progress report (MPR) under Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDMS), the details of the beneficiaries and expenditure incurred should be mentioned in the month in which the said benefits have been given to the beneficiaries i.e. the information on number of beneficiaries should not be the estimated number and also the expenditure should not be the funds released to State Government.

3. At present, States/UTs are sending quarterly progress report to this Department which is the average figure of three months of that particular quarter. Month-wise figure is not available in this Department which is required by DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat.

4. It is requested that necessary instructions may be given to the concerned officials in the State/UT to report the number of beneficiaries and expenditure incurred in the month when the benefits are actually transferred to the beneficiaries, to this Ministry by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each ensuing month. State Nodal Departments must ensure that there is no discrepancy in the report.

As you are aware, Aadhaar-based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is a significant governance reform ensuring transparency in targeted delivery of subsidies, benefits and services through effective use of technology. Ministries/ Departments implementing DBT schemes have been requested to report estimated benefits/ gains from implementing Aadhaar-based DBT, which are compiled and submitted to various authorities including the PMO.

2. In a meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 under the Chairmanship of Cabinet Secretary, all the Ministries/ Departments were directed to ensure regular reporting of captured savings/ gains from DBT with the approval of Secretary of respective Ministry/ Department to DBT Mission (Copy of minutes enclosed). A copy of Broad Guidelines/ Methodology for assessing benefits due to Aadhaar-based DBT, which have already been circulated to the stakeholders, is also enclosed for ready reference.

3. With the closing of Financial Year 2021-22, compilation of the data on DBT savings as on 31.03.2022, also indicating the methodology adopted for calculation/estimation of savings in respect of various DBT Schemes of your Ministry/ Department has become due. In case there are no savings to be reported, justification for the same also needs to be intimated.

4. DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat also submits a monthly report to the PMO on progress of DBT Schemes and Services achieved by Ministries / Departments. It is requested to kindly review the progress of your Ministry / Department and to ensure that the reporting of data on DBT Schemes/Services including details of budget allocation / expenditure for FY 2021-22 on DBT Bharat Portal, is complete in all respects.

5. I shall be grateful if you kindly issue appropriate instructions to the concerned officers to ensure reporting of DBT savings for FY 2021-22 (off-line) as well as uploading of data on monthly progress of DBT parameters on DBT Bharat Portal, at the earliest and not later than 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2022.

Respected Ma'am/Sir,

As you are aware, Aadhaar based Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is a major governance reform initiative of the Government to ensure targeted delivery of benefits and series, ensuring greater transparency and accountability in public services delivery through effective use of technology. Progress of DBT is being monitored regularly at the highest level and fortnightly progress report is to be sent on monthly basis.

2. During the meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017, Ministries were requested to start reporting of data on savings accrued due to implementation of DBT, without waiting for full Aadhaar seeding and that Aadhaar authentication of teachers & Para-teachers should be done as frequent as possible, preferably daily, while student authentication may be done once at the beginning of the year.


3. It is requested that scheme-wise report of savings occurred due to implementation of Aadhaar based DBT may be reported to this Ministry. Savings due to fake/Bogus /duplicate beneficiaries detected and deleted may also be reported within two weeks.

4. Further, protocol for Aadhaar authentication of teachers and para-teachers may also be prepared by each state so that authentication can be done daily.

5. It is requested that necessary instructions may be given to the concerned officials in the State/UT to report scheme-wise savings under Aadhaar based DBT schemes to this Ministry on email.id: schoolfivehrd@gmail.com. The savings from April 2017 onwards till September 2017 may be reported together and thereafter these may be reported on a monthly basis.
