Subject: - Release of Non-Recurring Central Assistance to **Government of Uttarakhand for Construction Kitchen-cum-Store** under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools during 2011-12.


Sir,

Government of India has decided to revise the norms for Construction of Kitchen-cum-Store under the Mid Day Meal Scheme on the basis of State Schedule of Rates and plinth area norm as prescribed 20 Sq. mt. Plinth areas for construction of Kitchen-cum-Store in schools having upto 100 children. For additional upto 100 children, additional 4 sq. mt. plinth areas will be added. The modified prescription of plinth area will have to conform to the above ceiling as laid down by this Department. Slab area of 100 children can be modified by States/UTs. The cost of construction of Kitchen-cum-Store will be shared between the Centre and the NER States on 90:10 basis and with other States/UTs on 75:25 basis.

2. Government of **Uttarakhand** vide letter no. SPO/282/MDM-22/2011-12 dated 17.10.2011 has sent a proposal for construction of Kitchen-cum-Store in the State. State Government has informed that there are 4855 schools, with all student strength of upto 100 Sq. Mtr., which still requires Kitchen-cum-Store. The State Government has prescribed the plinth area of 20 Sq. Mt., which is as per the norm prescribed by Government of India. The unit cost of construction of Kitchen-cum-Store as per State Schedule of Rate and as per plinth area norms. The State Government has proposed to construct 4855 Kitchen-cum-Store during this financial year i. e. 2011-12. The total funds required for construction of Kitchen-cum-Store has been worked out as **Rs.6803.86 lakhs**, out of which 75% Central share is **Rs.5102.88 lakhs** and 25% State share is **Rs. 1700.98 lakhs**.

3. It has been decided to release of **Rs. 5102.88 lakhs (Rupees Fifty One Crore Two Lakh and Eighty Eight Thousand only)** to the State Government of Uttarakhand for construction of 4855 Kitchen cum store under National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools for the year 2011-12. This amount is to be trifurcated into the following heads:-

(i) **Rs. 3631.22 lakhs** under Demand No. 58- Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (sub Major Head), 187 – National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Minor Head), 06 – Assistance to State (Sub-Head), 06.01 – Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support (Detailed Head), 06.01.35 – Grants for Creation of Capital Assets for 2011-12 (Plan).

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(ii) **Rs. 1316.54 lakhs** under Demand No. 58- Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), **789 – Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes**, 35 –National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Sub-Head), 01 – General Component (Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support), 01.35 – Grants for Creation of capital assets for 2011-12 (Plan).

(iii) **Rs. 155.12 lakhs** under Demand No. 58- Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), **796 – Schedule Tribes Sub Plan**, 25 – National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (sub-head), 01 – General Component (Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support), 35 – Grants for creation of capital assets for 2011-12 (Plan).

4. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to release of **Rs. 3631.22 lakhs (Rupees Thirty Six Crore and Thirty One Lakh and Twenty Two Thousand only)** to Govt. of **Uttarakhand** as a recurring Central assistance under National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools for the year 2011-12.

5. The above grant is subject to conditions that construction of Kitchen-cum-Store, which have already sanctioned during 2006-07 to 2009-10 and yet to be constructed would be completed within the earlier ceiling of Rs. 60,000/- per unit.

6. State Govt. will construct the Kitchen-cum-Store as per the plinth area norm prescribed by Govt. of India and State Schedule of Rates.

7. The conditions mentioned in NP-NSPE, 2006 and more particularly the following conditions contained in para 4.2 of the NP-NSPE, 2006 shall form part of the sanction and shall be followed by State:-

“...Kitchen-cum-Store should be separate from classrooms, preferably located at a safe, but accessible distance. They should be well ventilated and designed so that there is a separate storage facility with locks to check pilferage...”


8. The grant-in-aid is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The provisions of NP-NSPE, 2006 should be followed.
- (ii) The grantee shall utilize the grant-in-aid for construction of Kitchen-cum-Store under Mid-Day Meal Scheme in accordance with the provisions of the Rules and not divert the money for any other purpose.
- (iii) The grantee shall maintain a separate and proper account of the money received by it from Govt of India.
- (iv) State shall make appropriate budget provision in the State budget for this component, i.e., Kitchen-cum-Store.
- (v) The grantee shall maintain a Register of immovable properties and such other records as prescribed in the Rules.

9. The accounts of grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.

10. It is certified that the pattern of assistance under the Scheme has the prior approval of Ministry of Finance, Government of India. It is also certified that this grant is being released in conformity with the rules and principles of the Ministry of Finance.

11. No Utilization Certificate is pending for the previous year in respect of construction of Kitchen-cum-Store.

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
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- (v) The grantee shall maintain a Register of immovable properties and such other records as prescribed in the Rules.



On receipt of sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for affording credit to the balance of the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the State Government along with a copy to undersigned in the Department of School Education & Literacy. State Government shall send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of HRD, Department of School Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi-110115.

15. Grantee is located in **Uttarakhand** circle of account.


