# Release of funds under Mid Day Meal Scheme



- The funds under Mid Day Meal Scheme are released in two installments in the ratio of 60:40.
- To ensure uninterrupted implementation of the scheme, the first installment has been bifurcated into two installments and funds are released as under:
  - Ad-hoc release @ 25% of the central assistance quantified on the basis of PAB-MDM approval is released during April of the FY without insisting for the information on unspent balance.
  - The balance 35% (60-25) of the first installment is released on receipt of information on unspent balance from the State Governments, utilization certificate as per GFR Form 12-C and release of matching State Share against cooking cost and honorarium to cook-cum-helpers.
- The second installment is released after receipt of component wise information on the utilization of 60% or more funds available with the State.

# Information required for Release of funds under MDM



- Ad-hoc release @ 25% of the central assistance –
  - No information required
- The balance 35% of the first installment -
  - Unspent balance from the State Governments,
  - Utilization certificate as per GFR Form 12-C for the previous year releases
  - Release of matching State Share.
- Second installment –
  - Utilization of 60% or more funds available with the State,
  - Release of matching State Share.

- Ad-hoc release of Rs 2431.72 crore has been made to all States/UTs during April, 2017.
- Rs 46.16 crore have been released as balance of 1<sup>st</sup> installment to Mizoram and Telangana.
- Rs. 20.96 Cr. released to Chhattisgarh and Karnataka for drought as first installment.
