On the basis of concurrence received from the Department of Food & Public Distribution vide their OM No. 4-2/2020-BP.II, dated 24th February, 2020, 54267.40 MTs Food Grains (17908.24 MTs Wheat and 36359.16 MTs Rice) was allocated for State Government of Uttar Pradesh under Mid-Day-Meal Scheme for the 1st quarter of 2020-21 (April to June, 2020). A letter to this effect was issued to all States / UTs vide this Division's letter of even number, dated 27th February, 2020. It was also clarified that District Administration can lift foodgrains on monthly, bimonthly or quarterly basis from the FCI godowns starting from the 1st day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25th of the last month of the allocation quarter.

- 2. Government of Uttar Pradesh vide dated 15th September, 2020 (copy enclosed) has informed that due to prevailing circumstances during COVID-19 pandemic lock down situation, state was not able to lift 11848.276 MTs food grains (8662.638 MTs Rice and 3185.638 MTs Wheat) against the allocated 54267.40 MTs (36359.16 MTs Rice and 17908.24 MTs Wheat) food grains for the first quarter of 2020-21. The State has requested to grant permission to lift the foodgrains which comes under quota for the first quarter of 2020-21.
- 3. The Department of food & Public Distribution is therefore requested to issue necessary instructions to the concerned Regional Office of FCI to grant permission to Government of Uttar Pradesh for lifting the 11848.276 MTs food grains (8662.638 MTs Rice and 3185.638 MTs Wheat) allocated to them for the $1^{\rm st}$ quarter during the $3^{\rm rd}$ quarter i.e. by $31^{\rm st}$ October, 2020.

Allocation of foodgrains to States & UTs under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for the 1st Quarter (April to June, 2020) and 2nd Quarter (July to September, 2020) of financial year 2020-21.

Department of Food & Public Distribution has concurred the allocation of 1223647.40 tons of food grain comprising 203697.27 tons of wheat and 1019950.13 tons of rice vide O.M. No. 4-2/2020-BP-II dated 24.02.2020 to States & UTs at National Food Security Act (NFSA) rates i.e. Rs.2.00 per kg for wheat and Rs.3.00 per kg for rice under National Programme of Mid-Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for 1st Quarter (April to June, 2020) and 2nd Quarter (July to September, 2020) of 2020-21. Accordingly, the food grain allocation for States & UTs during each of the first two quarters of 2020-21 is forwarded herewith at *Annexure-I and II* respectively.

- 2. States & UTs are requested to further allocate the food grains to their districts as per their requirement on the basis of approved number of children and working days under intimation to this Department as well as to Food Corporation of India (FCI) for supply of food grains accordingly.
- 3. After receiving food grain allocation from the States & UTs, the District Administration will send a schedule (periodicity and date/week) of lifting of food grains to the local FCI depot depending upon its requirement, transportation convenience and storage capacity. The validity period for lifting of food grains will be as per extant guidelines.
- 4. District Administration can lift allocated food grains on monthly, bi-monthly or quarterly basis as indicated in its schedule, in accordance with the guidelines issued by Department of Food & Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution; Govt. of India vide their letter No. 1-2/2008-BP.II dated 18.9.2008, from the FCI godowns starting from the 1st day of the month preceding the allocation quarter and up to 25th of the last month of the allocation quarter. Districts officers are, therefore, required to be directed to lift the food grains accordingly.
- 5. Payment of the cost of food grains will be made by District authorities within 20 days of the receipt of bills from FCI as per the guidelines issued by this Department vide letter No. 1-15/2009- Desk(MDM) dated 10.2.2010. The guidelines for decentralization of payment of cost of food grains to FCI at district level under MDM Scheme can also be downloaded from the website of this Department www.mdm.nic.in. These instructions may be followed strictly by all States & UTs.

- 2. The validity period for lifting of foodgrains will be as per extant guidelines.
- The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy may communicate State/UT-wise allocation of the allocated quantity of foodgrains to FCI and States/UTs well in time and ensure its lifting within the stipulated validity period by States/UTs.
- Food Corporation of India (FCI) would issue rice and wheat as per State-wise allocation for the year 2020-21 with monthly breakup to be made by the Department of School Education and Literacy. Ministry of Human Resource Development.
- The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy is also requested to furnish consolidated Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma GFR - 19A duly signed by the concerned Director for the foodgrains allocated to them under Mid Day Meal Scheme for the year 2019-20.
- The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development may ensure that FCI gets full payment in respect of foodgrains released by it to States/UTs under the Scheme & utilization certificates are furnished by the State/UT Governments to it in time. They are also requested to make payment of outstanding amounts to FCI without any delays as FCI bears huge amount of interest on unpaid outstanding amount.

- 6. Procedure laid down in para 3.6 to 3.9 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 10.02.2010 on decentralization of payment of cost of food grains shall be followed meticulously to ensure that the best quality food grains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality (FAQ), is lifted from the FCI godown. The process followed at the time of receipt of food grains from FCI depots should be repeated at each level till the foodgrains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality food grains are delivered for consumption by children. Records/samples to ensure quality should be maintained at all levels.
- 7. As per para 5.2 of the above mentioned guidelines dated 10.02.2010, a monthly report on payment to FCI and quantity of food grains lifted and released to schools/cooking agency may be furnished in the prescribed format (Annexure-III) latest by 15th of the each following month strictly on regular basis. The Monthly Progress Report (MPR) may also be emailed at rajeevkumar.edu@nic.in on monthly basis.
- 8. The States & UTs will furnish utilization certificate of the food grains supplied under the Scheme during the year 2019-20 latest by 30.06.2020 in the format enclosed at <u>Annexure-IV</u> to enable GOI to release allocation of food grains for the 3rd and 4th Quarter before 1st week of August, 2020. In the utilization certificate, only the quantity actually consumed at the school/cooking agency level will be indicated as utilized. Whatever remains in school/cooking agency/Block/District level stores/godowns will be shown as unspent balance.

Subject: Revised Guidelines regarding validity period for the lifting of foodgrains under Other Welfare Schemes i.e. MDM, WBNP, SAG, Annapurna Scheme and Welfare Institutions and Hostels Scheme.

The undersigned is directed to say that allocation of foodgrain is made by Department of Food & Public Distribution in respect of following Schemes and Programs of Government of India:

- (a) National Food Security Act, 2013;
- (b) Other Welfare Schemes (OWS)
 - 1. Mid Day Meal Scheme Department of School Education & Literacy.
 - 2. Wheat Based Nutrition Programme Ministry of Women & Child Development.
 - 3. Scheme for Adolescent Girls Ministry of Women & Child Development.
 - 4. Annapurna Scheme Ministry of Rural Development.
 - 5. Allocation of Foodgrain under Welfare Institutions & Hostels Scheme Department of Food & Public Distribution.
- 2) In respect of allocation of foodgrain made under NFSA, the offtake of foodgrain pertaining to any allocation month should be completed by States/UTs by the last day of the month preceding the allocation month, so that the eligible beneficiaries could receive their entitled quota of foodgrain during the allocation month itself; failing which States/UTs are liable to pay Food Security Allowance to such beneficiaries under Food Security Allowance Rules, 2015.
- 3) Secondly, in respect of allocation of foodgrain made under Other Welfare Schemes, different Schemes are governed by different guidelines. There is lack of uniformity in validity period for making offtake of foodgrain among the above 5 OWSs. In order to bring uniformity in this regard, the following has been decided (in supersession of DFPD's lifting guidelines for OWSs vide its Order No.1-2/2008-BP-II dated 18.07.2008 and 18.09.2008):
 - i) <u>Monthly Allocation</u> Foodgrain pertaining to any particular month under above 5 OWSs, should be lifted by the last day of the month preceding the allocation month;
 - ii) <u>Quarterly Allocation</u> In case the allocation of foodgrain is made by the concerned Ministry/Department on quarterly basis under any of the above OWSs, the States/UTs would have the option either to lift the foodgrain on monthly basis, as per validity schedule mentioned at (i) above or at one go on quarterly basis, subject to the condition that the offtake of foodgrain for the particular quarter should be completed between first day of the month preceding the allocation quarter till the last day of the second month of the said quarter, unless otherwise communicated by Department of Food & Public Distribution in individual cases. The advance lifting of foodgrain would be further subject to the availability of stock in the Central Pool;
 - iii) Department of Food & Public Distribution's guidelines dated 6-Feb-2014 and 6-Nov-2018 regarding advance lifting of foodgrain upto 6 months for TPDS/NFSA/OWS would continue to be in vogue;

- iv) In case the last date for lifting happens to be a public holiday, the same will have to be done upto the previous working day;
- v) If the allocated quantity of foodgrain is not lifted in full by the specified date, the lifting of balance quantity of foodgrain will be as per extant norms;
- vi) If the allocated quantity of foodgrain is not available in the assigned FCI depot/godown, it will have to be lifted from the nearest alternate depot/godown assigned by FCI for this purpose;
- vii) The foodgrain has to be released to the concerned State/UT by FCI in the ratio as decided by DFPD;
- viii) Since the allocation of foodgrain by FCI to States/UTs under above Schemes/Programmes is on pre-payment basis, States/UTs should deposit the cost well in time so that the lifting of foodgrain could be ensured as per above schedule.
- 4) This issues with the approval of competent authority.
