

## 2. Executive Summary of all the district reports

#### 2.1 Regularity in Serving Meal

District 1: Doda	Out of 37 sample schools (15 PS, 18 PS with UPS, 04 UPS with Sec/H.Sec), in 36 schools (15 PS, 17 PS with UPS, 04 UPS with Sec/H.Sec), hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. However, hot cooked meal was not found on the day of visit in remaining one primary with upper primary school namely MS City Doda (Boys). The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2002 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1538 (about 77 percent) on the day of visit.
District 2: Kishtwar	<ul> <li>In all the 37 sample schools (13 PS, 22 PS with UPS, 02 UPS with Sec/H.Sec), hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. However, hot cooked meal was not found on the day of visit in one primary school namely PS Gujjar Basti due to non availability of the students on the day of visit.</li> <li>The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 1879 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1306 (about 70 percent) on the day of visit.</li> </ul>
District 3: Kathua	In all the 37 sample schools (15 PS and 22 PS with UPS) covered in the study, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2293 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1976 (over 86 percent) on the day of visit.

#### 2.2 Regularity in Delivering Food Grains to School

District 1: Doda	All the 37 sample schools have received the food grains on regular basis. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, only in 07 schools food grains was found to be delivered at the schools by lifting agency. However, in remaining 30 schools, the food grains have not been delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.
District 2: Kishtwar	<ul><li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 36 schools have received the food grains on regular basis. However, remaining one school namely PS Gujjar Basti was not found to receive the food grains on regular basis.</li><li>In all the 37 schools covered in the study, food grains were not found to be delivered at the schools by lifting agency.</li></ul>
District 3: Kathua	Out of 37 sample schools covered in the study, 36 schools have received the food grains on regular basis. However, remaining one school namely GMS Chak Rijju was not found to be received the food grains on regular basis. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, only in 04 schools food grains was found to be delivered at the schools by lifting agency. However, in remaining 33 schools, the food grains have not been delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.

#### 2.3 Regularity in Delivering Cooking Cost to School

District 1: Doda	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 16 schools, cooking cost in advance was received regularly. However, there has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in remaining 21 schools. The delay was generally of 3 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 2: Kishtwar	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only one school (NPS Dangar Mohalla Kurya), cooking cost in advance was received regularly. However, there has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in remaining 36 schools. The delay was generally of 3 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 3: Kathua	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, only in 02 schools (GMS Chak Rijju and GMS Chak Sajjan), cooking cost in advance was received regularly. However, there has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in remaining 35 schools. The delay was generally of 5 to 6 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.

#### 2.4 Social Equity

District 1: Doda	In all the 37 schools visited by the MI, no gender or caste or community based
	discriminations in cooking or serving or sitting arrangements has been observed. The
	children were made to sit together and took cooked food in the same manner.
District 2: Kishtwar	In all the 37 schools visited by the MI, no gender or caste or community based
	discriminations in cooking or serving or sitting arrangements has been observed. The
	children were made to sit together and took cooked food in the same manner.
District 3: Kathua	In all the 37 schools visited by the MI, no gender or caste or community based
	discriminations in cooking or serving or sitting arrangements has been observed. The
	children were made to sit together and took cooked food in the same manner.

#### 2.5 Variety of Menu

District 1: Doda	Out of the 37 schools, in only 11 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 26 schools, weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. Out of 37 schools visited by the MI, in 36 schools, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis. However, in remaining one school (MS City Boys), MDM was not found to be served on the day of visit.
District 2: Kishtwar	Out of the 37 schools, in only 12 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 25 schools, weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. In all the 37 schools visited by the MI, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis.
District 3: Kathua	Out of the 37 schools, in 29 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 08 schools, weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. Out of 37 schools visited by the MI, in 36 schools, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis. However, in remaining one school (GPS Kaniyari), MDM was not found to be served according to menu on the day of MI's visit.

District 1: Doda	Children ware been with quality of food in all the 26 comple schools where the MDM

	adequate in 21 schools and average in 15 schools.
District 2: Kishtwar	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 36 sample schools where the MDM

	visit was found to be good in 08 schools and average in 28 schools.
	Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 36 sample schools where the
	MDM was found to be served on the day of visit. Further, the quantity was found to be
	adequate in 23 schools and average in 13 schools.
District 3: Kathua	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 37 sample schools. The Quality
	being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 04 schools and average in
	33 schools.
	Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 37 sample schools. Further, the
	quantity was found to be adequate in all the 37 schools covered in the study.

District 1: Doda	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 02 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 35 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 04 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 33 schools, it was not found to be maintained.

District 2: Kishtwar	<ul> <li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 06 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 31 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit.</li> <li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 06 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 31 schools, it was not found to be maintained.</li> </ul>
District 3: Kathua	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 21 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 16 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 13 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 24 schools, it was not found to be maintained.

#### 2.8 Status of Cooks

District 1: Doda	There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement
	of all the 37 sample schools.
	An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 06 schools, the remuneration paid to
	cooks/helpers have found to regular. However, in remaining 31 schools, the payment of remuneration of cooks was found to be irregular.
	Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC/ST, OBC and Minority category.
	Further, out of 39 cooks/helpers, 36 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively
	and about 90 percent of them belong to SC/ST, OBC and minority categories.
District 2: Kishtwar	There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement
	of all the 37 sample schools.
	An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only one school namely PS Dangar Mohalla
	Kurya, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers have found to regular. However, in
	remaining 36 schools, the payment of remuneration of cooks was found to be irregular.
	Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC/ST, OBC and Minority category.
	Further, out of 44 cooks/helpers, 42 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively
	and about 55 percent of them belong to SC/ST, OBC and minority categories.
District 3: Kathua	There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement
	of all the 37 sample schools.
	An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.
	In all the 37 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers have
	found to be irregular.
	Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC/ST, OBC and Minority category.
	Further, out of 51 cooks/helpers, 50 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively
	and about 65 percent of them belong to SC/ST, OBC and minority categories.
	and about 05 percent of them belong to be/51, obe and minority categories.

#### 2.9 Infrastructure

District 1: Doda	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 34 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-			
	cum store. However, in remaining 03 schools, no pucca kitchen shed cum store			
	facilities have been found.			
	In 03 schools accounting to above 8 percent of the total sample, the pucca kitchen shed-			
	cum store has not been constructed. Further, in these 03 schools, the food grains have			
	been stored in the classrooms of schools and the food being cooked at the classrooms,			
	Veramdah and open place.			
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and			
	drinking in 36 schools. However, in remaining one school (NPS Dhori), the drinking			
	water facility was not found.			
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, there were adequate numbers of cooking			
	utensils was found in the 36 schools. However, in remaining one school (GGHS			
	Bhalla), available cooking utensils was found to be inadequate. Further, 28 schools			

	have been provided the eating plates to the students. However, remaining 09 schools have not been provided eating plates to the students. Out of 37 sample schools, in 36 schools, hot cooked meal have found to be cooked on the day of visit. Further, out of 36 schools, the fire wood was being used in 17 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 08 schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in 06 schools and kerosene was being used as fuel in 05 schools.
District 2: Kishtwar	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 24 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed- cum store. However, in remaining 13 schools, no pucca kitchen shed cum store facilities have been found. In 13 schools accounting to above 35 percent of the total sample, the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further, in these 13 schools, the food grains have been stored in the classrooms of schools. However, the food being cooked at the classrooms in 05 schools, at open place in 06 schools and in the house of the cooks in 02 schools. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and drinking in 32 schools. However, in remaining 05 schools, the drinking water facility was not found. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, there were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in the 35 schools. However, in remaining 02 schools (NPS Naryan and GHS Pather Naki), available cooking utensils were found to be inadequate. Further, 31 schools have been provided the eating plates to the students. However, remaining 06 schools have not been provided eating plates to the students. Out of 37 sample schools, in 36 schools, hot cooked meal have found to be cooked on
	the day of visit. Further, out of 36 schools, the fire wood was being used in 25 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in one school, both the firewood and kerosene was being used in 03 schools, both the cooking gas and kerosene was being used in another one school, while only kerosene was being used as fuel in 06 schools.
District 3: Kathua	<ul> <li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 32 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-cum store. However, in remaining 05 schools, no pucca kitchen shed cum store facilities have been found.</li> <li>In 05 schools accounting to about 14 percent of the total sample, the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further, in these 05 schools, the food grains have been stored in the classrooms of schools. However, the food being cooked at the classrooms in 02 schools (PS Chak Sona Noopa and GMS Kathua 'A') and at open place in 03 schools (GMS Chak Shekhan, GMS Kalibari and GPS Kathan).</li> <li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and drinking in 35 schools. However, in remaining 02 schools (PS Chak Sona Noopa and GPS Haripur), the drinking water facility was not found.</li> <li>Out of 37 schools covered in the study, there were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in 36 schools. However, in remaining one school (GPS Narayanpur), available cooking utensils were found to be inadequate. Further, all the 37 schools have been provided the eating plates to the students.</li> <li>Out of 37 sample schools, the fire wood was being used in 18 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 04 schools.</li> </ul>

#### 2.10 Safety and Hygiene

District 1: Doda	In all the 37 sample schools, the storage places were found in satisfactory condition. All the 37 sample schools, from safety and hygiene point of view, have been found in satisfactory category. In all the schools, children wash their hands after the taking meals. The teacher encourages them to wash their hands also before eating. All the school's children eat MDM in an orderly manner and conserve water while washing dishes.
District 2: Kishtwar	In all the 37 sample schools, the storage places were found in satisfactory condition. All the 37 sample schools, from safety and hygiene point of view, have been found in satisfactory category.

	In all the schools, children wash their hands after the taking meals. The teacher encourages them to wash their hands also before eating. All the school's children eat MDM in an orderly manner and conserve water while washing dishes.
District 3: Kathua	Out of 37 sample schools; the storage places were found in good condition in 17 schools, in satisfactory condition in 19 schools and in poor condition in one school. Out of 37 sample schools; from safety point of view, 17 schools have been found in good condition, 19 schools have been found in satisfactory condition and one school has been found in poor condition. Out of 37 sample schools; from Hygiene point of view, 17 schools have been found in good condition, 19 schools have been found in satisfactory condition and one school has been found in poor condition. Out of 37 sample schools; from Hygiene point of view, 17 schools have been found in good condition, 19 schools have been found in satisfactory condition and one school has been found in poor condition. In all the schools, children wash their hands after the taking meals. The teacher encourages them to wash their hands also before eating. All the school's children eat MDM in an orderly manner and conserve water while washing dishes.
