## 2. Executive Summary of all the district reports

### 2.1 Regularity in Serving Meal

District 1: Udhampur	Out of 39 sample schools covered in the study, in 34 schools, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. However, in remaining 05 schools, hot cooked meal was not found to be provided on the day of visit. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2840 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 2492 (about 88 percent) on the day of visit.
District 2: Samba	Out of 40 sample schools covered in the study, in 28 schools, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. However, in remaining 12 schools, hot cooked meal was not found to be provided on the day of visit. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2304 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1776 (over 77 percent) on the day of visit.
District 3: Reasi	In all the 39 schools covered in the study, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 1863 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1458 (over 78 percent) on the day of visit.

### 2.2 Regularity in Delivering Food Grains to School

District 1: Udhampur	Out of 39 schools covered in the study, 34 schools have received the food grains on regular basis. However, remaining 05 schools were not found to be received the food grains on regular basis. In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the food grains have not found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.
District 2: Samba	Out of 40 schools covered in the study, 28 schools have received the food grains on regular basis. However, remaining 12 schools were not found to be received the food grains on regular basis. In all the 40 schools covered in the study, the food grains have not found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.
District 3: Reasi	All the 39 schools covered in the study have received the food grains on regular basis. In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the food grains have not found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.

### 2.3 Regularity in Delivering Cooking Cost to School

District 1: Udhampur	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in all the 39 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 2: Samba	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in all the 40 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 3: Reasi	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in all the 39 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.

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## 2.5 Variety of Menu

District 1: Udhampur	Out of the 39 schools, in 37 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 02 schools (PS Khoulaban and GMS Lower Garnai), weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. Out of 39 sample schools covered in the study, in 34 schools, hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, in all the 34 schools, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis.
District 2: Samba	Out of the 40 schools, in 25 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 15 schools, weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. Out of 40 sample schools covered in the study, in 28 schools, hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, out of 28 schools, in 25 schools, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis. However, in remaining 03 schools, food items were not found to be served according to menu on the day of visit.
District 3: Reasi	Out of the 39 schools, in 31 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 08 schools, weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. In all the 39 schools covered in the study, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis.

## 2.6 Quality and quantity of Meal

District 1: Udhampur	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 34 schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 04 schools and average in 30 schools. Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 34 sample schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in all the 34 schools.
District 2: Samba	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 28 schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 09 schools and average in 19 schools. Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 28 schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in all the 28 schools.
District 3: Reasi	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 39 schools covered in the study. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 16 schools and average in 23 schools. Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 39 sample schools covered in the study. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in all the 39 schools.

## 2.7 Supplementary

District 1: Udhampur	Out of 39 schools covered in the study, in 28 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 11 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit. Out of 39 schools covered in the study, in only 17 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 22 schools, it was not found to be maintained.
District 2: Samba	Out of 40 schools covered in the study, in 17 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 23 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit. In all the 40 schools covered in the study, health card was not found to be maintained.

District 3: Reasi	<p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, in 36 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 03 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit.</p> <p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, health card or health register was not found to be maintained.</p>
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## 2.8 Status of Cooks

District 1: Udhampur	<p>There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of all the 39 sample schools.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</p> <p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</p> <p>Majority of the cooks were found to be from general category. Further, out of 49 cooks/helpers, 36 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</p>
District 2: Samba	<p>There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of all the 40 sample schools.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</p> <p>In all the 40 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</p> <p>Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC and OBC category. Further, out of 62 cooks/helpers, 59 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</p>
District 3: Reasi	<p>There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of all the 39 sample schools.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</p> <p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</p> <p>Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC/ST category. Further, out of 46 cooks/helpers, 42 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</p>

## 2.9 Infrastructure

However, in remaining one school (MS Lower Kawa), no pucca kitchen shed cum store facilities have been found.</p> <p>In one school (MS Lower Kawa), the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further, cooking of the food and storage of the food grains have found to be in the additional classroom of the school.</p> <p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and drinking in 34 schools. However, in remaining 05 schools, the drinking water facility was not found.</p> <p>There were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in all the 39 schools covered in the study. Further, out of 39 schools, 34 schools have also been provided the eating plates to the students.</p> <p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, the fire wood was being used in 12 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 23 schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in 04 schools.</p>
District 2: Samba	<p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, 32 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-cum store. Further, out of 39 schools, 38 schools have also been provided the eating plates to the students.</p> <p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, the fire wood was being used in 29 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 04 schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in 06 schools.</p>
