2. Executive Summary of all the district reports

2.1 Regularity in Serving Meal

District 1: Jammu	Out of 40 sample schools covered in the study, in 30 schools, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. However, in remaining 10 schools, hot cooked meal was not found to be provided on the day of visit. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2682 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1926 (about 72 percent) on the day of visit.
District 2: Rajouri	In all the 39 schools covered in the study, hot cooked meal was being provided on daily basis. The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to be 2371 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1966 (about 83 percent) on the day of visit.

2.2 Regularity in Delivering Food Grains to School

District 1: Jammu	Out of 40 schools covered in the study, 26 schools have received the food grains on regular basis. However, remaining 14 schools were not found to be received the food grains on regular basis. Out of 40 schools covered in the study, in only 05 schools, the food grains have found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency. However, in remaining 35 schools, the food grains have not found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.
District 2: Rajouri	All the 39 schools covered in the study have received the food grains on regular basis. In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the food grains have not found to be delivered at the schools by the lifting agency.

2.3 Regularity in Delivering Cooking Cost to School

District 1: Jammu	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in all the 40 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 2: Rajouri	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in all the 39 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.

2.4 Social Equity

District 1: Jammu	In all the 40 schools visited by the MI, no gender or caste or community based discriminations in cooking or serving or sitting arrangements has been observed. The children were made to sit together and took cooked food in the same manner.
District 2: Rajouri	In all the 39 schools visited by the MI, no gender or caste or community based discriminations in cooking or serving or sitting arrangements has been observed. The children were made to sit together and took cooked food in the same manner.

2.5 Variety of Menu

District 1: Jammu	Out of the 40 schools, in 36 schools, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed. However, in remaining 04 schools (PS University Campus, GGMS Gorkha Nagar, GBMS Gorkha Nagar and GHS Kasim Nagar), weekly menu for MDM has not found to be displayed. Out of 40 sample schools covered in the study, in 30 schools, hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, in all the 30 schools, food items were being served according to menu on daily basis.
District 2: Rajouri	In all the 39 schools covered in the study, new weekly menu for MDM has been displayed.

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2.6 Quality and quantity of Meal

District 1: Jammu	<p>Children were happy with quality of food in all the 30 schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 03 schools and average in 27 schools.</p> <p>Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 30 sample schools where hot cooked meal was found to be provided on the day of visit. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in 22 schools and average quantity was found to be served in 08 schools.</p>
District 2: Rajouri	<p>Children were happy with quality of food in all the 39 schools covered in the study. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 32 schools and average in 07 schools.</p> <p>Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 39 schools covered in the study. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in 29 schools and average quantity was found to be served in 10 schools.</p>

2.7 Supplementary

District 1: Jammu	<p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, in 37 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 03 schools, Micro nutrients and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed till the date of MI's visit.</p> <p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, in only 02 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 38 schools, it was not found to be maintained.</p>
District 2: Rajouri	<p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed.</p> <p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, health card or health register have not found to be maintained.</p>

2.8 Status of Cooks

District 1: Jammu	<p>There were adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of all the 40 sample schools.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</p> <p>In all the 40 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</p> <p>Majority of the cooks were found to be from SC category. Further, out of 74 cooks/helpers, 71 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</p>
District 2: Rajouri	<p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, in 18 schools, adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of the schools. However, in remaining 21 schools, inadequate number of cooks were found to be available to meet the requirement of the schools.</p> <p>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</p> <p>In all the 39 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</p> <p>Majority of the cooks were found to be from general category. Further, out of 42 cooks/helpers, 41 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</p>

2.9 Infrastructure

District 1: Jammu	<p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, 39 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-cum store. However, in remaining one school (PS University Campus), no pucca kitchen shed cum store facilities have been found.</p> <p>In one school (PS University Campus), the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further, cooking of the food and storage of the food grains have found to be in the Girls Higher Secondary School.</p> <p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and drinking in 39 schools. However, in remaining one school (GPS Deichak), the drinking water facility was not found.</p> <p>There were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in all the 40 schools covered in the study. Further, all the 40 schools have also been provided the eating plates to the students.</p> <p>Out of 40 schools covered in the study, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 37 schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in 02 schools. However, only fire wood was also found to be used in remaining one school (PS Mangu Chak).</p>
District 2: Rajouri	<p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, 37 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-cum store. However, in remaining 02 schools (GMS Ward No. 8 New and GPS S.C. Colony), no pucca kitchen shed cum store facilities have been found.</p> <p>In 02 schools (GMS Ward No. 8 New and GPS S.C. Colony), the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further, cooking of the food and storage of the food grains have found to be in the additional classroom in GMS Ward No. 8 (New) while in GPS S.C. Colony, cooking of the food was found in the residence of the cook.</p> <p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and drinking in 31 schools. However, in remaining 08 schools, the drinking water facility was not found.</p> <p>There were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in all the 39 schools covered in the study. Further, out of 39 schools, 31 schools have also been provided the eating plates to the students.</p> <p>Out of 39 schools covered in the study, the fire wood was being used in 04 schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 22 schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in remaining 13 schools.</p>
