

#### 2. Executive Summary of all the district reports

# District 1: PoonchOut of 37 schools covered in the study, in 34 schools, hot cooked meal was being<br/>provided on the day of visit. However, in remaining 03 schools (PS Upper Madana,<br/>GMS Kojra and GMS Mohalla Azad), hot cooked meal was not found to be provided<br/>on the day of MI's visit.<br/>The level of enrolment of the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to<br/>be 2619 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 1924 (over 73 percent) on<br/>the day of visit.District 2: RambanIn all the 37 schools covered in the students in the school on the date of visit was reported to<br/>be 3494 (boys and girls). Total attendance was found to be 2698 (over 77 percent) on<br/>the day of visit.

#### 2.3 Regularity in Delivering Cooking Cost to School

District 1: Poonch	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in 18 schools out of 37 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.
District 2: Ramban	There has been a delay in delivering the cooking cost in 34 schools out of 37 schools covered in the study. The delay was generally of 3 to 4 months. Further, the school's head teacher bought the things on credit from local traders to keep the programme running.

	daily basis.
District 2: Ramban	In all the 37 schools covered in the study, new weekly menu for MDM has been
	displayed.

#### 2.6 Quality and quantity of Meal

District 1: Poonch	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 34 schools where MDM was found to be cooked on the day of MI's visit. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be good in 11 schools and average in 23 schools. Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 34 schools where MDM was found to be cooked on the day of MI's visit. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in all the 34 schools.
District 2: Ramban	Children were happy with quality of food in all the 37 schools covered in the study. The Quality being served on the day of MI's visit was found to be average in all the 37 schools. Children were happy with quantity of food in all the 37 schools covered in the study. Further, the quantity was found to be adequate in all the 37 schools.

#### 2.7 Supplementary

District 1: Poonch	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 33 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 04 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in only 04 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 33 schools, health card or health register have not found to be maintained.
District 2: Ramban	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 28 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were being distributed. However, in remaining 09 schools, supplementary diets (Micro nutrients) and de-warming tablets were not found to be distributed. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 09 schools, health card or health register have found to be maintained. However, in remaining 28 schools, health card or health register have not found to be maintained.

#### 2.8 Status of Cooks

District 1: Poonch	In all the 37 schools covered in the study, adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of the schools. An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers. Out of 37 schools covered in the study, in 19 schools, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be regular. However, in remaining 18 schools, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular. Majority of the cooks were found to be from minority category. Further, out of 62
District 2: Ramban	<ul> <li>cooks/helpers, 59 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</li> <li>In all the 37 schools covered in the study, adequate number of cooks and helper were found to meet the requirement of the schools.</li> <li>An amount of Rs. 1000 per month was provided to cooks/helpers.</li> <li>In all the 37 schools covered in the study, the remuneration paid to cooks/helpers has found to be irregular.</li> <li>Majority of the cooks were found to be from minority and general category. Further, out of 78 cooks/helpers, 62 cooks/helpers were found to be women respectively.</li> </ul>

#### 2.9 Infrastructure

District 1: Poonch	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 24 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-
	cum store. However, in remaining 13 schools, no pucca kitchen shed cum store
	facilities have been found.
	In 13 schools, the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further,
	cooking of the food and storage of the food grains have found to be in the additional
	classrooms in all the 13 schools.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and
	drinking in 34 schools. However, in remaining 03 schools (MS Bela Janyate, PS
	Mohalla Panditan and GMS Mohalla Azad), the drinking water facility was not found.
	There were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in all the 37 schools
	covered in the study. Further, all the 37 schools have also been provided the eating
	plates to the students.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 19
	schools, while both the cooking gas and firewood was being used as fuel in 18 schools.
District 2: Ramban	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, 31 schools have fully constructed kitchen shed-
	cum store. However, in remaining 06 schools, no pucca kitchen shed cum store
	facilities have been found.
	In 06 schools, the pucca kitchen shed-cum store has not been constructed. Further,
	cooking of the food and storage of the food grains have found to be in the additional
	classrooms in all the 06 schools.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, potable water was available for cooking and
	drinking in 34 schools. However, in remaining 03 schools (GGMS Marog, MS Panchal
	and Govt. UPS Darshi Pura), the drinking water facility was not found.
	There were adequate numbers of cooking utensils was found in all the 37 schools
	covered in the study. Further, out of 37 schools, 28 schools have also been provided the
	eating plates to the students.
	Out of 37 schools covered in the study, the fire wood was being used as fuel in 04
	schools, cooking gas was being used as fuel in 28 schools, while both the cooking gas
	and firewood was being used as fuel in 03 schools. However, in remaining 02 schools,
	kerosene oil was also found to be used as fuel.

#### 2.10 Safety and Hygiene

District 1: Poonch	In all the 37 sample schools; the storage places were found in satisfactory condition. All the 37 sample schools; from safety and hygiene point of view, have been found in satisfactory condition.
	In all the schools, children wash their hands after the taking meals. The teacher encourages them to wash their hands also before eating.
	All the school's children eat MDM in an orderly manner and conserve water while washing dishes.
District 2: Ramban	In all the 37 sample schools; the storage places were found in satisfactory condition. All the 37 sample schools; from safety and hygiene point of view, have been found in satisfactory condition. In all the schools, children wash their hands after the taking meals. The teacher encourages them to wash their hands also before eating. All the school's children eat MDM in an orderly manner and conserve water while
	washing dishes.

#### 2.11 Community Participation

District 1: Poonch	Community participation in MDM had not been a regular practice. In cent percent (37 schools) of the schools, the parents have not monitored and supervised the MDM on daily basis.
District 2: Ramban	Community participation in MDM had not been a regular practice. In cent percent (37 schools) of the schools, the parents have not monitored and supervised the MDM on daily basis.
