Steps taken to strengthen the monitoring mechanism in the Block, District and State level and status of constitution of SMCs at these levels, Status of formation on standing Committee at village/school/cooking agency level.

At the school level, P.T.A, is entrusted with the work of monitoring the scheme. At taluka level the scheme is monitored by the Adult Education Supervisor and A.D.E.I.s. Besides, all the officers from this Directorate and of the Zonal level who are on school inspections, monitor the scheme. The State Nodal Officer also monitors the implementation of the Mid Day Meal Scheme in the state. The implementation of the scheme is being reviewed by Secretary(Education).

> Strategy for establishment of monitoring cell at various levels viz. Block, District and State level for effective monitoring of the scheme.

The Vocational Education Officer of the Directorate of Education has been appointed as State Nodal Officer for the Mid Day Meal Scheme. He visits the various talukas to check the quality and quantity of the meal supplied under the scheme to check the Mid Day Meal being supplied to the students. Other officials of the department who are on inspection of the schools have been asked to check the Mid Day Meal Scheme. Besides, the A.D.E.I.s and the Supervisors posted at taluka places inspect samples of Mid Day Meal, one school a day and 5 schools a day respectively.

Arrangement for official inspections to MDM centres and percentage of schools inspected and summary of findings and remedial measures.

100% schools are inspected during the year 2010-11, where Mid-Day Meal is supplied by official of this Department. Whenever necessary instruction were given to Self Help Group.
