# PAB-MDM Meeting to consider and approve AWP&B 2019-20

**APPRAISAL NOTE** 

**STATE: Arunachal Pradesh** 

#### a. Good practices

- a) Fresh fruits like apples, oranges, bananas are supplied on nominal cost to schools by village community.
- b) Nutrition gardens have been set up in the premises of 221 out of 3182 schools.

#### b. Issues

- a) Less coverage of children against PAB approval in districts like Longding (62%) in primary category and West Siang (44%) in upper primary category.
- b) Only 618 (10%) cook-cum-helpers were trained out of 6105.
- c) Firewood is used as a mode of cooking in 98% schools.
- d) There is a delay in release of funds from State to schools (6 months).
- e) Less number of schools (only 1%) are reporting data under Automated Monitoring System (AMS).
- f) Data entry into MDM-MIS portal is not complete (Annual: 13%, Monthly 0%).
- g) Health check-up has been carried out for only 106437 (64%) children, out of total enrolment of 167565 children. IFA tablets have been distributed to only 42650(25%) children.
