- i. Delay in construction of 767 units of kitchen-cum-stores.
- ii. Low utilization of MME funds (40%).

- i. Provision of Sukhdi (sweet) from own resources.
- ii. Provision of Breakfast for school children within the MDM budget.
- iii. School Nutrition Garden set up in 2898 schools.
- iv. Community participation through Tithi Bhojan.
- v. Serving of milk under Dudh Sanjeevani in 12 districts.
- vi. Anna Triveni Yojana Free Food Grain to Tribal Girls.60kg (per term 30 kg) food gains (10kg wheat,10kg Rice,10kg Corn) is given to the tribal girls in a year.

Part B: Review of the Performance of the scheme during 2018-19

1. Coverage of children and PGI points:

The PAB-MDM has approved 26,72,852 children at primary and 17,24,388 children at upper primary level. Out of which 26,05,009 children at primary and 16,94,020 children at upper primary have availed Mid Day Meal on an average basis during the year.

Under 'Performance Grading Index' (PGI), the State Government of Gujarat obtained score of 10 against the weight age of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.7 i.e. "% of elementary school's children taking MDM against target approved in PAB – in Govt. and aided schools".

2. School Working Days:

The PAB-MDM has approved 248 working days at both primary and upper primary level, out of which Mid Day Meal was served on 243 days at both primary and upper primary levels. Under 'Performance Grading Index' (PGI), the Gujarat obtained score of 10 against the weight age of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.8 i.e. "% of days Mid Day Meal served against total working days – Govt. and aided elementary schools".

3. Kitchen cum store:

Central assistance of Rs. 23203.15 Lakh has been released for construction of 25077 Kitchen-cum-Stores during the financial years of 2006-07 to 2018-19. As on 31.3.2019, construction has been completed for 24308 Kitchen-cum-stores and is in progress for 2 kitchen-cum-stores. construction work not yet starred in 767 schools.

5. Kitchen Devices (new as well as replacement):

Central assistance of Rs.1677.00 lakh has been released towards procurement of 33540 units during the financial years of 2006-07 to 2018-19 and the State has procured all of them. State has also procured all 29868 units of kitchen devices, which were sanctioned as replacement with an outlay of Rs. 1493.40 lakh.

6. School Nutrition Gardens:

2898 schools are having Nutrition Gardens and it is proposed to develop Nutrition Gardens in 11744 schools with an estimated expenditure of Rs 587.20 Lakh, which comprises of Rs 352.32 lakh as central share and Rs 234.88 lakh as State share under the 5% flexibility component. After detailed discussion, PAB-MDM approved setting up of School Nutrition Gardens in 11744 schools, with an outlay of Rs Lakh comprising of Rs 352.32 lakh as central share and Rs 234.88 lakh as State share.

7. School Health Programme (Rashtritya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), Weekly Iron & Folic Acid Supplementation, National De-worming Day etc.) and Nutrition in convergence with other Ministries:

Government of Gujarat has informed that health check up has been carried for 52,51450 (96 %) children, out of 54,88,319 enrolled children.

8. Tithi Bhojan:

State provided 102.71 lakh meals to 43.91 lakh children in 42,245 schools during 2018-19.

9. Training of Cook cum Helpers:

Training has been imparted to all the 96329 cook-cum-helpers in 34307 schools with the help of Satellite communication via BISAG.

10. Cooking Competition:

State has proposed to organize cooking competitions at various levels i.e. Block, District and State level in all 34307 schools.

11. Supplementary nutritional items (milk, egg etc.):

The State is providing additional item in the form of 200 ml flavored milk to 4.81 lakh children 5 days a week in 26 blocks of 12 districts from State's own resources.

12. Data Entry on MIS-Web Portal:

Gujarat has completed Annual data entry for 100% schools. However, monthly data of 93% schools has been entered.

13. Status of implementation of Automated Monitoring System:

State has reported by 29882 (Ave no. of schools) schools i.e. 87% schools on AMS.

14. Usage of Temples, Gurudwaras, Jails etc.:

State is not in a position to involve jails for the provision of MDM. State shall explore the possibilities for involving Temples and Gurudwaras for providing Mid Day Meal.

15. Centralized kitchens:

Centralized kitchens have been engaged for supplying mid day meals to 5,46,590 children, covering 3,327 Schools in 8 districts (Gandhinagar, Ahemdabad, Bhavnagar, Rajkot, Vadodara, Valsad, Surat and Navsari).

16. Awareness generation activities:

State has not carried out activities for awareness generation during 2018-19, however, it has been mentioned that IEC activities shall be carried out during 2019-20.

17. Social Audit:

Social Audit has been conducted in 2 Districts viz. Mehsana and Mahisagar.

18. Use of LPG:

LPG is being used as mode of fuel for preparation of Mid Day meal in 100% schools.

19. Meeting of District level Steering cum Monitoring Committee:

42 meetings of DLSCMC under the chairpersonship of the DC have taken place.
