APPRAISAL NOTE

UT: Lakshadweep

1.Good practices

- a) MDM is being provided to children studying up to XII class.
- b) Additional food items like Egg, Fish, Chicken, Fruits, etc. are provided.
- c) Double Fortified Salt is used for preparation of Mid Day Meal.
- d) Additional cooking cost of Rs 10.00 in Primary and Rs 11.70 in Upper Primary is being provided over and above the central assistance.
- e) Additional Honorarium to cook-cum-helpers (i.e. Rs 8500/- per month per CCH) is being given.
- f) E-transfer of honorarium to all CCH is being done from UT Administration's resources.

2.Issues

- g) UT of Lakshadweep uses firewood as mode of cooking. The UT has been advised to use LPG in phase manner or at least smoke lesschulhas.
- h) The UT has very less Utilization of MME i.e. only 44%.
- i) No meeting of District Level Committee (0%) has been convened during 2018 19, where as it is mandatory to conduct one meeting per month.
- j) No training has been imparted to Cook Cum Helpers (0%) in UT of Lakshadweep.
- k) No proper management structure is found available in UT of Lakshadweep.

4. Review of Performance during 2018-19

4.1 Performance on PGI indicators:

There are two indicators of Mid Day Meal Scheme in the Performance Grading Index (PGI) i.e. i) Score against the weightage of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.7 i.e. "% of elementary school's children taking MDM against target approved in PAB – in Govt. and aided schools" and ii) Score against the weightage of 10 for indicator No 1.3.8 i.e. "% of days Mid Day Meal served against total working days – Govt. and aided elementary schools."

4.2 Coverage of children:

The PAB-MDM has approved 4073 children at primary and 2738 children at upper primary level, out of which 4469 children at primary and 2248 children at upper primary have availed Mid Day Meal on an average basis during the year 2018-19.

Under 'Performance Grading Index' (PGI), the UT of Lakshadweep obtained score of 10 against the weightage of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.7 i.e. "% of elementary school's children taking MDM against target approved in PAB – in Govt. and aided schools". It was observed that there is a significant difference in the proportion of children covered at primary and upper primary level as is evident from 109% coverage at primary level compared to 82% at upper primary level as against PAB-MDM approval. The UT was advised to take necessary steps to enhance the coverage of children at upper primary level.

4.3 School Working Days:

The PAB-MDM has approved 220 working days both at primary and upper primary level. Mid Day Meal was served on all 220 working days for primary and upper primary levels. Under Performance Grading Index (PGI), the UT of Lakshadweep obtained score of 10 against the weightage of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.8 i.e. "% of days Mid Day Meal served against total working days – Govt. and aided elementary schools".

4.4 Kitchen-cum-Stores:

UT has not proposed any kitchen cum store during 2019-20. Kitchen cum stores in schools of UT of Lakshadweep are provided from UT budget.

4.5 Kitchen Devices (new as well as replacement):

UT has not proposed any kitchen devices during 2019-20. Kitchen Devices in schools of UT of Lakshadweep provided from UT budget.

4.6 School Health Programme (Rashtritya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), Weekly Iron & Folic Acid Supplementation, National De-worming Day etc.) and Nutrition in convergence with other Ministries:

It was observed that health check up has been carried out for 5231 children, out of total enrolment of 6957 children.

4.7 Training of Cook-cum-Helpers and other capacity building activities:

UT has informed that out of total 110 engaged cook-cum-helpers in schools, no training has been imparted to any cook-cum-helpers during FY 2018-19.

4.8 Data Entry on MDM-MIS Web Portal:

MDM-MIS portal captures information on critical indicators of MDMS. The annual data entry module captures master data on availability of kitchen-cum-stores, kitchen devices, number of cook-cum-helpers engaged, mode of cooking etc. The monthly data entry module captures data on number of days Mid-Day Meal was served; number of meals served, honorarium paid to cook-cum-helpers engaged, number of children received IFA tablets, number of children screened under Rashtritya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) etc. The UT of Lakshadweep has completed 100% Annual and Monthly data entries in the MIS portal.

Status of implementation of Automated Monitoring System (AMS):

AMS has been put in place for real time monitoring of MDMS. Data on number of meals served on the particular day and reasons if meals not served is being captured from schools with no cost to school head masters/teachers. Out of 39 schools, daily data has been reported by 24 schools i.e. 62% schools on Automated Monitoring System. In this regard, email alerts are being sent to all States/UTs on daily basis.

UT has informed that billboards have been placed at all prominent places to create awareness of the scheme.

4.12 Social Audit:

No Social Audit has been conducted during FY 2018-19.

4.13 Meeting of District Level Steering-cum-Monitoring Committee:

As per the information provided by the UT, only one meeting of District Level Steering-cum-Monitoring Committee under the chairpersonship of the District Collector have taken place against the mandated twelve.
