APPRAISAL NOTE

UT : PUDUCHERRY

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a. Good practices

- a) UT of Puducherry provides Mid Day Meal to children of Pre-Primary & Class IXth to XIIth from UT's own resources.
- b) UT of Puducherry is also providing Free Transport facilities (Free Bus) for the Students from I to XII Std from UT's own resources.
- c) Additional Nutritious item: Egg is being provided twice a week from UT Budget with expenditures of Rs. 2 crore.
- d) Additional Contribution in cooking cost viz; Rs. 4.55 for primary and Rs. 4.89 for upper primary is being provided over and above mandatory UT share.
- e) Payment of Honorarium to Cook-cum-helpers is being made ranging from Rs. 4458/- to Rs 19000/- per month depending on their seniority.
- f) UT of Puducherry follows the concept of Central Procurement system by limited tenders through registered suppliers.
- g) Safe drinking water with RO systems is available in all 429 schools.
- h) Training of Cook-cum-helpers is being done regularly by Puducherry Institute of Hotel Management and Catering, sponsored by the Govt. of India
- i) Regular testing of Food Samples is being done by Department of Food and Drugs Testing, UT of Puducherry.

b. Issues

- a) Less coverage of children- At upper Primary level the coverage is 75% as compared to Primary level where the coverage of children against enrollment is 82%. In the District of Karaikal the coverage of children is 66% only at upper Primary level. UT officials informed that in Karikal district most of the children come from affluent families studying in Govt. aided schools and hence don't take Mid Day Meal and bring their own Tiffin.
- b) Less coverage of working days- At primary level total working days approved was 210 and at upper primary level was 220. Against this UT has covered 203 at primary and 203 at Upper primary respectively.
- c) Delay in construction of kitchen-cum-stores- 13 Kitchens are in progress
- d) Low utilization of MME funds. Only 5% funds has been utilized against the allocation under MME
- e) Less number of schools reporting data under Automated Monitoring System (AMS)- 377 schools i.e. 88% schools on board on AMS.
- f) Social Audit under Mid Day Meal Scheme is yet to be initiated.

PART- B Review of the performance of the scheme during 2018-19

1. Coverage of children:

The PAB-MDM has approved 26231 children at primary and 19235 children at upper primary level, out of which 25875 children at primary and 18715 children at upper primary have availed Mid Day Meal on an average basis during the year 2018-19.

Under 'Performance Grading Index' (PGI), the UT of Puducherry obtained score of 10 against the weightage of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.7 i.e. "% of elementary school's children taking MDM against target approved in PAB – in Govt. and aided schools". The UT of Puducherry was advised to take necessary steps to enhance the coverage of children both at primary and upper primary level. It was also observed that the coverage is below the UT average in district of Karaikal where the coverage of children is 66% only at upper primary level.

2. School Working Days:

The PAB-MDM has approved 210 working days at primary and 220 working days at upper primary level, out of which Mid Day Meal was served on 203 working days for both primary and upper primary levels respectively. Director, UT of Puducherry mentioned that 7 days schools had to be closed due to heavy rains. The officials of UT of Puducherry intimated that 17 days under Upper primary could not be covered and the same will be looked into. Under 'Performance Grading Index' (PGI), the UT of Puducherry obtained score of 10 against the weightage of 10 for indicator No. 1.3.8 i.e. "% of days Mid Day Meal served against total working days – Govt. and aided elementary schools".

3. Kitchen-cum-Stores:

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Central assistance of Rs. 149.47 Lakh has been released for construction of 105 Kitchencum-Stores from 2006-07 to 2017-18. As on 31.3.2019, construction has been completed for 92 Kitchen-cum-stores and construction work is in progress for 13 kitchen-cum-stores. The UT of Puducherry Government informed that construction work will be completed by 31st December, 2019.

4. Kitchen Devices (new as well as replacement):

Central assistance of Rs. 31.80 lakh has been released towards procurement as well as replacement of 636 units of kitchen devices.

5. School Health Programme (Rashtritya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), Weekly Iron & Folic Acid Supplementation, National De-worming Day etc.) and Nutrition in convergence with other Ministries:

It was observed that health check up has been carried out for 56,516 children, out of total enrolment of 56,516 children.

6. Training of Cook-cum-Helpers and other capacity building activities:

UT of Puducherry has informed that training has been imparted to all the 1031 cook-cumhelpers engaged in 429 schools, with the help of Puducherry Institute of Hotel Management and Catering, sponsored by the Govt. of India.

7. Data Entry on MDM-MIS Web Portal:

MDM-MIS portal captures information on critical indicators of MDMS. The annual data entry module captures master data on availability of kitchen-cum-stores, kitchen devices, number of cook-cum-helpers engaged, mode of cooking etc. The monthly data entry module captures data on number of days Mid-Day Meal was served; number of meals served, honorarium paid to cook-cum-helpers engaged, number of children received IFA tablets, number of children screened under Rashtritya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) etc. The UT of Puducherry has completed 100% Annual and Monthly data entries in the MIS portal.

8. Status of implementation of Automated Monitoring System (AMS):

AMS has been put in place for real time monitoring of MDMS. Data on number of meals served on the particular day and reasons if meals not served is being captured from schools with no cost to school head masters/teachers. Out of 429 schools, daily data has been

reported by 414 schools i.e. 96% schools on Automated Monitoring System. In this regard, email alerts are being sent to all the States/UTs on daily basis.

9. Centralized kitchens:

Centralized kitchens have been engaged for supplying meal to 44590 children, covering 429 Schools in all 4 districts. (Karaikal, Yanem, Mahe, Pondicherry) run by Department of Education, UT of Puducherry.

10. Awareness generation activities:

UT of Puducherry has informed that following activities have been carried out for awareness generation MDM Logo / Daily Menu are being displayed in all the schools. Adequate awareness has been created among the general public about the programme.

11. Social Audit:

Social Audit has not been conducted so far. UT of Puducherry has proposed to cover Karaikal and Puducherry districts under Social Audit during 2019-20

12. Meeting of District Level Steering-cum-Monitoring Committee:

As per the information provided by the UT of Puducherry, one meeting of District Level Steering-cum-Monitoring Committee under the chairpersonship of the District Collector.

Other proposals and issues discussed

Under Break Fast scheme UT of Puducherry, 100 ml hot milk is being provided to all children every day .
