
Subject: - National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools – Release of non-recurring Central Assistance for procurement of Kitchen Devices – 2011-12.

Sir,

The Government has taken decision to release non-recurring Central Assistance of ₹ 191.10 lakh (Rupees One Crore Ninety One Lakh and Ten Thousand only) to the State Government of Haryana for provisioning of Kitchen Devices in 3822 schools @ ₹.5,000/- per school in the State Under the National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools (Mid Day Meal Scheme), as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi) of the Guidelines of NP-NSPE, 2006. The amount of ₹ 191.10 lakhs is bifurcated as under:


- (i) ₹ 138.74 lakh under 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 187 – **Elementary Education-National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Minor Head)**, 06 – Assistance to States (Sub Head), 06.01 – Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support (Detailed Head), 06.01.35 – Grants for creation of capital assets for 2011-12 (Plan), and
- (ii) ₹ 52.36 lakh under 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 04 – Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 789 – **Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Minor Head)**, 35 – Elementary Education-National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools, 35.01 – Assistance to States-(Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support), 35.01.35 – Grants for creation of capital assets for 2011-12 (Plan).

2. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of non-recurring grant-in-aid of ₹ 52.36 lakh (**Rupees Fifty Two Lakh Thirty Six Thousand only**) to the **State Government of Haryana** for provisioning of Kitchen Devices in 3822 schools in the State under the National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Mid-

3. As far as possible procurement of Kitchen Devices shall be done in a decentralized manner, preferably at school/block level, so that there is no delay in making available the required devices to the schools.
4. The expenditure of ₹ 52.36 lakh (Rupees Fifty Two Lakh Thirty Six Thousand only) on this account shall be debitable to Demand No. 58- Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601-Grants-in-aid to State Govt. (Major Head), 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 789 – **Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Minor Head)**, 35 – Elementary Education-National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools, 35.01 - Assistance to States-(Amount to be met from Gross Budgetary Support), 35.01.35 – Grants for creation of capital assets for 2011-12 (Plan).
5. The grantee shall maintain a separate and proper account of grant received through this sanction letter and not divert the same for a purpose other than it has been sanctioned for.
6. A Register of Assets acquired out of this grant shall be maintained as per rules.
7. It is certified that the pattern of assistance under the Scheme has the prior approval of Ministry of Finance, Government of India. It is also certified that this grant is being released in conformity with the rules and principles of the Ministry of Finance.
8. No UC is pending for the previous years.
9. The accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.
10. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of HRD, Department of School Education & Literacy, D-Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. On receipt of sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for affording credit to the balance of the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the State Government along with a copy to undersigned in the Department of School Education & Literacy. State Government shall send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of HRD, Department of School Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.
