

3. An honorarium of Rs. 2000/- each per day shall be paid to Dr. A. Laxmaiah, Team leader and Dr Arlappa, member JRM. An honorarium of Rs. 1000/- each per day shall be paid to Dr Anwar Basha, Mr. K. Sree Ramakrishna, Ms. Neeraja and Mr. Sunu PV, Research assistants of the Mission.
4. It is, therefore, requested to kindly depute a senior level official who is well-versed with the implementation of the scheme to accompany the team and also facilitate their visits to various institutions in the State.
5. It is also requested to kindly intimate the arrangements made and also the name of the official who has been deputed for facilitating the arrangements for the visit of the team to the State.
