1. Introduction:

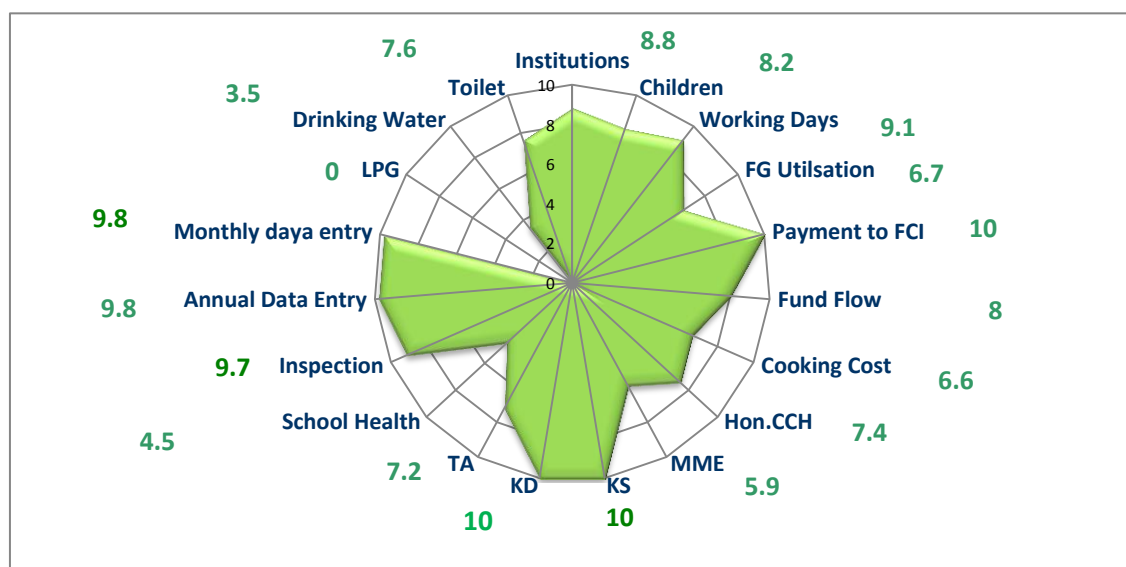
Approved outlay by the Programme Approval Board – Mid Day Meal Scheme (PAB-MDM) for the year 2016-17 is Rs. 2771.80 lakh. The Central Govt. has released Ad-hoc Recurring Central Assistance of Rs. 578.63 lakhs to Govt. of Manipur on 13.04.2016.

5. Challenges in implementation of MDMS

The main challenges in smooth implementation of the scheme are as under:

- Less coverage of working days up to 31.12.2015
- Construction work of 2305 units of the sanctioned kitchen cum stores is still in progress.
- Poor implementation of school health programme (Health check-up conducted only for 45% of the enrolled children)
- No LPG connection in any school.

6. Best Practices being followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- Dissemination of information on release of fund and foodgrains from State to block level officials through SMS Service.
- Disciplinary proceedings initiated against default teachers for their irregularities towards the implementation of the scheme.
- Participation by the Mothers / Parents/ Community members while implementing the scheme.
- Kitchen garden in some schools.
