

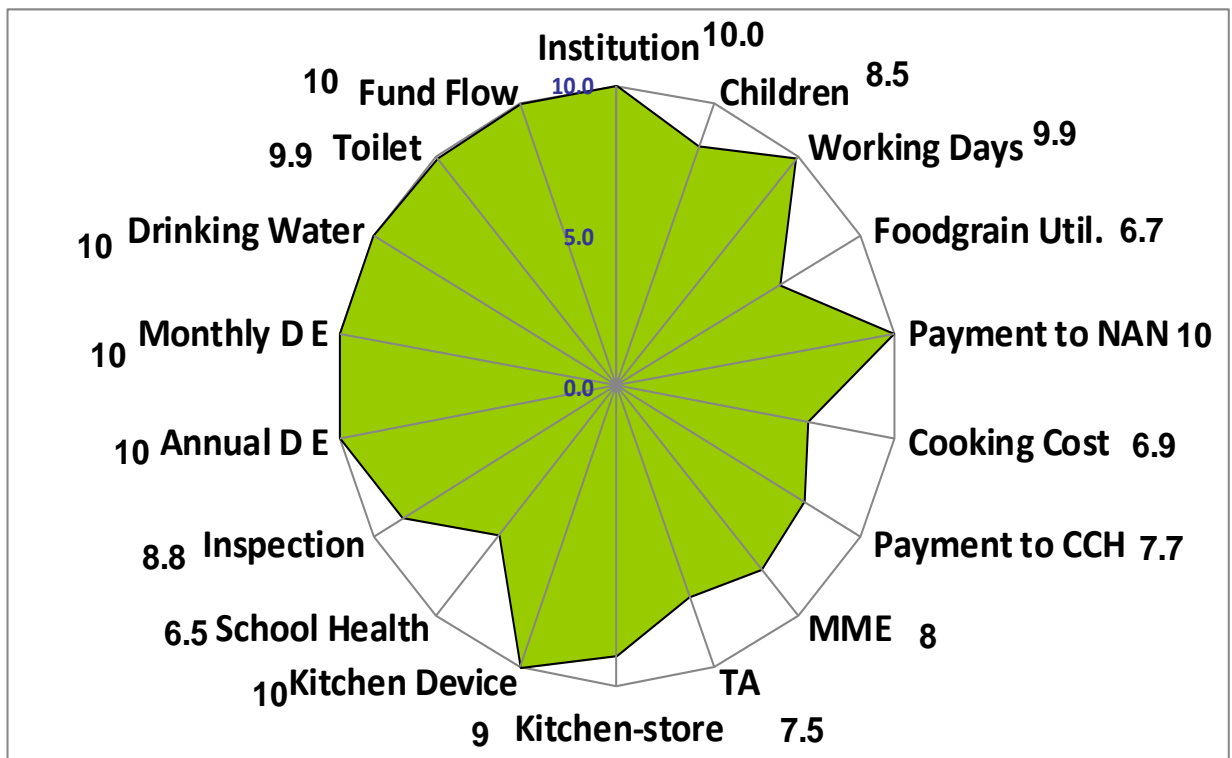
**Brief Note on Mid Day Meal Scheme
(Chhattisgarh)
(19-05-2017)**

1. Approved outlay by the Programme Approval Board – Mid Day Meal Scheme (PAB-MDM) for the year 2017-18 is Rs. 306.31 Crore as central share. PAB has also approved Rs. 3.88 crore as central share for serving of MDM in draught affected areas during summer vacation. The Central Govt. has released Rs. 73.77 crore as ad-hoc grant on 1st May, 2017.

5. Challenges in implementation of MDMS

- i) Parents/community tastes meals in only 3% schools before it is served to children.
- ii) Mismatch in data from MDM-MIS and AWP&B.
- iii) Data in AMS is submitted for 20% schools only.
- iv) Firewood used as fuel in 96% schools.
- v) No meeting of District level committee under chairpersonship of the senior most MP of the Lok Sabha in 24 districts.

6. Best Practices being followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- i) Pre-positioning of one month's funds with implementing agencies.
- ii) All Cook-cum-helpers and Self Held Groups have bank accounts.
- iii) E-transfer of funds to SHGs and cooks.
- iv) Women engaged in the Self Helps Group in rural areas.
- v) Additional State share of Rs. 200 in honorarium for each CCH.
- vi) Software developed for on line management and monitoring of food grain, payment of cooking cost and honorarium of cooks cum helper.
