1. Introduction

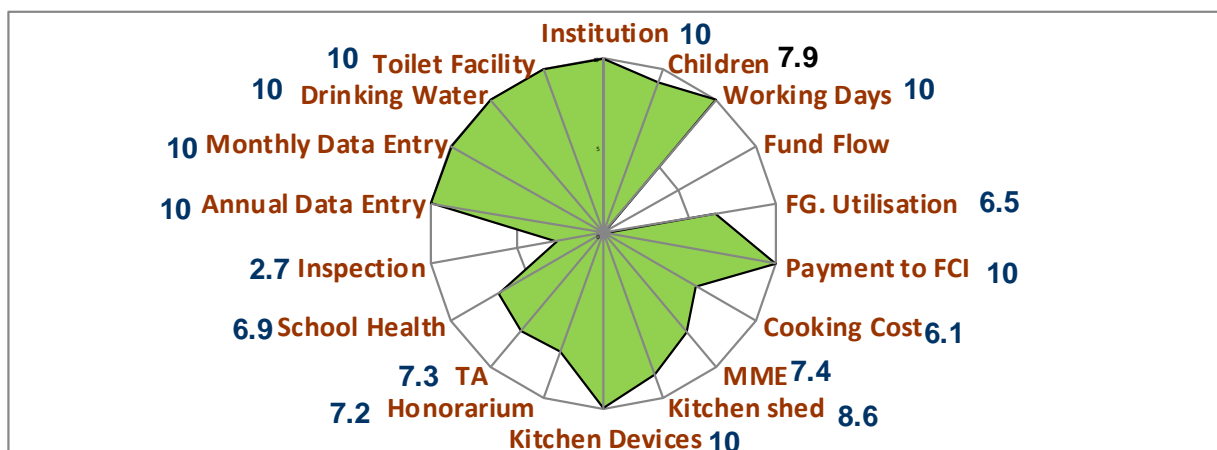
Approved outlay by the Programme Approval Board – Mid Day Meal Scheme (PAB-MDM) for the year 2017-18 is Rs.396.36 Lakhs (Central share). The Central Govt. has already released Ad-hoc Recurring Central Assistance of Rs. 97.50 lakhs to U.T Administration of A&N Island as on 27.04.2017, 1st Installment Recurring Central Assistance of Rs. 135.69 lakhs to U.T Administration of A&N Island as on 14.07.2017, 2nd Installment Recurring Central Assistance of Rs. 77.73 lakhs to U.T Administration of A&N Island as on 30th November, 2017.

5. Challenges in implementation of MDMS in A& N Islands

The main challenges in smooth implementation of the scheme are as under:

- I. Less utilization of food grains (65%) and cooking cost (61%).
- II. Construction of Kitchen-cum-stores are yet to be started in 110 schools (44%).
- III. Payment of honorarium to cook-cum-helpers is 72%.
- IV. LPG 29%.
- V. Utilization of MME funds is 74%.
- VI. Mismatch in data reported through AWP&B and MDM-MIS

6. Best Practices being followed in the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- I. UT share of cooking cost is Rs. 6 Pcpd for Primary and Upper Primary both.
- II. The scheme is regularly monitored by the VECs, PTA and Mothers' Committee.
- III. This UT provides boiled eggs twice a week and ripened banana once a week to the all the students enrolled in primary to Upper Primary stage as additional food items.
- IV. Double fortified salt is being used in cooking of Mid Day Meals.
