4. Challenges in implementation

- i. Social audit not conducted in the State.
- ii. Against 40.48 lakh enrolled children State covered 33.37 lakh (7.70 lakh children not covered).
- iii. State has shown zero pending bills towards the payment of cost of food grains to FCI whereas Rs. 58.60 cr. is pending as per FCI record. This should be resolved.
- iv. 6478 Kitchen-cum-Stores not constructed as yet. These Kitchen-cum-stores were sanctioned during 2007-08 to 2011-12 (2007-08 = 118 kitchens, 2008-09 = 1802 kitchens, 2009-10 = 78 kitchens and in 2011-12 = 4480 kitchens.). Funds made available is ₹ 90 Cr. This should be resolved.
- v. Repair of 12114 kitchen-cum-stores and 30497 units of kitchen devices were approved by PAB 2020-21 but State unable to submit the necessary documents asked by IFD.
- vi. No health check-up of children, distribution IFA and Deworming tablets to the children.

i. Distribution of dry ration at the doorsteps of the children during closure of school due to Covid-19 pandemic.
