## 4. Challenges in the implementation of PM (POSHAN)

- 1) The State of Meghalaya has submitted the proposal for release of balance of 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment but IFD has made observations on the proposal and therefore information is being sought from the State Govt. and the same is awaited from the State of Meghalaya.
- 2) Social Audit was conducted in 2019-20 in 2 districts Ri-Bhoi and West Jantia Hills, since then no report has been submitted till now.
- 3) The Status report of Repair work for 3390 Kitchen-cum-Stores have not been furnished for which Rs. 305.10 Lakh were released on 19th March 2020.
- 4) Testing of food samples have never been done in the State.

5) Only 7% children were screened under Health check up programme and 7% children were distributed IFA tablets. No Children were distributed D-Worming tablets during 2020-21.

## 5. Best Practices followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- 1) Corpus Fund of Rs. 10 crores is pre-positioned at the beginning of the year by the State Finance Department for smooth functioning of PM (POSHAN).
- 2) From State direct E-transfer of cooking cost to schools and payment of honorarium to Cookcum-helpers in their bank account.
- 3) Best Practice Award has been initiated for schools for maintaining Nutritional Garden, serving meals in lunch boxes, hand washing facility etc..
- 4) In Meghalaya PM (POSHAN) is publicized through All India Radio Shillong, Tura and Jowai and in AIR FM Jongphi @ 103.6 Mhz in Local language.

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
