4. Challenges in implementation of PM (POSHAN)Tripura

- The State of Tripura submitted the proposal without PFMS Undertaking and for this GOI sent letter dated 9th November 2021 with a request to furnish the undertaking duly signed by the Secretary, Govt of Tripura. Recently on 10th November 2021, GOI has received the signed PFMS Undertaking.
- State Govt of Tripura has not yet submitted the Actual Expenditure Statement for release of additional funds for distribution of Food Security Allowance during Covid-19 pandemic for FY 2020-21.
- 3) Social Audit as proposed by the State last year, was not conducted during 2020-21.
- 4) Only 12% children were screened under Health check up programme and 20% children were distributed IFA tablets during 2020-21.

5. Best Practices followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- 1) Eggs are served to all children twice a week.
- 2) Mushroom have been introduced in PM (POSHAN) in 388 school in Gomti district in Kakraban Block on pilot basis.
- 3) Nutrition Garden developed in 1639 schools.
- 4) Additional Contribution in Honorarium i.e. Rs.500/- per cook-cum-helper provisioned from State's own resources.
- 5) Rs.4.96 crore has been provided for installation of LPG Connections and refuelling in 3239 schools from State's own resources.
- 6) 340 schools are having dining halls constructed from State's own resources with the help of PWD and Tripura Housing Development & Construction Board, Govt. of Tripura.
- 7) During the year 2020-21, the Department has made a documentary on Kitchen Garden for Awareness Generation & Media campaign.
