- I. Social Audit not conducted during FY-2020-21,
- II. Testing of Food Sample not conducted during FY-2020-21,
- III. Less utilisation of Transport Assistance,
- IV. Less utilisation of MME.

## 6. Best Practices being followed in the UT of Chandigarh for effective implementation of the scheme:-

- I. UT provides Rs. 4.09 for Primary and Rs. 3.84 for Upper primary over and above the central assistance for cooking cost.
- II. UT provides Rs. 2300/- per month over and above the central assistance for Honorarium to Cook cum Helpers,
- III. UT provides additional funds for transporting hot cooked meal from Centralized Kitchen to School from UT resources.
- IV. 100% Children of UT of Chandigarh are having Aadhaar.
- V. In UT of Chandigarh, Centralized Kitchens are using 100% LPG as source of fuel.
- VI. 85% Schools have Water Filtration Facility through MPLAD Funds. All the Schools have Multi tap facility for hand washing.
- VII. Fortification of Rice & Wheat has been implemented from UT Funds.
- VIII. School Nutrition Gardens have been developed in cluster based Kitchens.
- IX. Kitchen waste is utilized for preparation of compost.
