## Brief Note on PM (Poshan) (Manipur)

 Approved outlay by Programme Approval Board (PAB-PM POSHAN) for the Year 2021-22 is Rs.3038.03 Lakh (including Summer Vacation Budget of Rs.199.77 Lacs). Central Govt. has already released of Ad-hoc and Balance of First instalment of Central Assistance for Rs. 1678.74 Lacs to the Govt. of Manipur. Further, an amount of Rs. 194.27 lakh was lying as unspent balance. The same was re-validated to be utilized during 2021-22.

### 4. Challenges in implementation of PM (Poshan) Scheme in Manipur

- I. Delay of more than 8 months in release of funds from State to school.
- II. No Separate PM (Poshan) Directorate Exist in State.
- III. Very slow progress in construction of kitchen cum stores (only 37% constructed). (1370 KS for Rs.2147.49 Lacs sanctioned in 2010-11 Not yet completed)
- IV. No Health Check-up / WIFS distribution to children under Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram.
- V. Social Audit not conducted in any of the district.
- VI. State has not conducted testing of food samples.
- VII. No dedicated Person available at Block / District level to implement and monitor the PM (Poshan) Scheme in day to day basis.

# 5. Best Practices being followed in the State for effective implementation of the scheme:-

I. Participation by the Mothers / Parents/ Community members in implementation of the scheme.

#### 6. Pending Issues:

i. 2<sup>nd</sup> and final instalment could not be released to the State Government as proposal for balance of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment was received at the fag end of the year 2021-22. The amount of Rs. 1022.96 lakh was released as balance of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment and FSA during summer vacation for the year 2021-22. Further, it may be stated that the proposal for committed liability has still not been received by the State Government. The same would be considered only after due State share is released on PFMS.

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
