Assurances: 2016-17

Andhra Pradesh

- Completion of construction of all the remaining 30007 kitchencum-stores by 31.03.2017.
- Submission of proposal for 19523 kitchen-cum-stores as per plinth area norm and as per State Schedule Rates.
- To make concrete efforts to provide LPG connections to at least 75% schools during 2016-17.
- Restore Green Channel System of fund releases for MDM.
- Enhance the participation of parents in monitoring of MDM.
- To extend social audit across the State.

Bihar

- The State Government will submit the proposal district wise based on plinth area norm of 5024 kitchen cum stores and surrender the remaining amount of Central share at the earliest.
- It will complete construction of remaining 2894 (4%) kitchen cum stores by December 2016.
- Provision of LPG connections for 60% schools in phased manner by the year 2016-17.
- Better convergence with health department.
- Furnish the ATNs on all the pending 42 complaints.

Goa

- Ensure timely payment of honorarium to cook-cumhelpers.
- Health Department would be requested to provide IFA and de-worming tablets for all children.
- Proper utilization of funds under MME.

Gujarat

- Improve the coverage of children against enrolment
- Opening of bank accounts of 22446 engaged cook cum helpers in phased manner.
- Fixing norms of time and distance taken in reaching of meals to the farthest school from the Centralized kitchen.
- Completion of Construction of 2308 (in progress) and 830 yet
 to start kitchen-cum-stores by March 2016.

Karnataka

- To make provision of mobile app or SMS system for daily monitoring of the scheme and generate exception reports for Tahsildars for ATN.
- To complete 1784 (4%) in progress kitchen-cum-stores by the end of the current financial year.
- Utilization of LPG as fuel in the remaining 3% of schools soon.
- To clear all pendency of the bills raised by FCI.
- To look into the reasons of low coverage in Dharwad and if possible will arrange decentralized kitchens.
- To have consultations with the existing food labs for maintaining the food quality served in the schools by centralized kitchens.

Kerala

- Cooking cost would be provided @ 5.78 per child per day in upper primary during the remaining period of 2015-16.
- Remunerations of cook-cum-helpers would be e-transferred into their bank accounts in phased manner.
- LPG would be introduced in schools in Kerala in a phased manner
- Construction of 33 kitchen-cum-stores to be completed by 31.03.2016.
- Kitchen devices for 2606 schools sanctioned during 2006-07 would be procured immediately.

Kerala... conti...

- Instructions to be issued to the District Authorities to give top priority to the payment of FCI bills and district authorities to hold monthly meetings with FCI for reconciling their record on payment of FCI bills.
- Health Department would be requested to provide IFA, and deworming tablets for all children.
- Food samples would be tested from FSSAI laboratories in Kochi.
- Social Audit would be conducted in two districts by independent institute.

Maharashtra

- E- transfer of funds in all the remaining 20 districts and payment of honorarium to cooks in their bank accounts by June 2016 and Submit ATN on the findings reported by MI.
- Complete the remaining 7446 kitchen-cum-stores by December, 2016 and surrender Rs. 3415.80 lakh for 5693 kitchen sheds sanctioned where land is not available.
- Install LPG connections in 50% of the remaining non LPG schools (64008) and provision of storage bins in schools by December, 2016.
- Before the commencement of next session i.e. 1st July 2016, the automated monitoring system will be in place.

Maharashtra conti...

- Ensure serving of MDM to children in drought affected districts during summer vacation.
- Take corrective measure to improve MDM implementation in poor performing districts and also to streamline the tendering process in future.
- Issuance of circular for monitoring of the Scheme on daily basis by
 2 parents every day.
- Installation of multi tap wash facility in large schools in the first phase

Tamil Nadu

- To explore the usage of SMS or any other mobile application for real time monitoring and roll out by 25th June 2016 in the State.
- Provision of LPG connections to remaining 28855 (67%) noon meal centers after elections are over in the State.
- To complete all the sanctioned 11177 (39%) kitchen-cum-stores by June, 2016 and pursue the management of 8056 Govt. aided schools for construction of Kitchen-cum-stores in the schools.
- To look into the issue of poor performing districts and take corrective measures and revisit the menu in Kanyakumari district as per the likings of the children.
- To prepare per day administrative cost of an organizer in the schools and share with the Ministry.
- State assured to install multi wash facility in large schools in the first phase

Telengana

- Completion of Construction of 20331 sanctioned kitchen-cum-stores by 31.03.2017.
- Centralized kitchen will be replaced with school based kitchen in a phased manner in rural areas during 2016-17.
- Pending bills of FCI will be cleared within stipulated time.
- Concrete efforts will be made to provide LPG connections to remaining (52%) schools.
- Health Department would be requested to provide IFA and de-worming tablets for all children.
- Ensure to maintain and check accuracy of data entered in the MDM-MIS web portal.
- Provision of hand washing facilities in all remaining 25% schools

Uttar Pradesh

- e-transferring of honorarium in bank account of cook-cum-helpers in urban areas in first phase
- Construct 488 kitchen-cum-stores on the basis of plinth area norms and State Schedule
 Rate and surrender the remaining funds to GOI
- Provide LPG connections to the remaining schools 72259 (43%) during 2016-17 from the funds available under appropriate head of the Scheme.
- Clear all pending FCI bills.
- Make efforts to increase the attendance of the children in the schools and look into the issue of poor performance of the scheme in the low performing districts. Take corrective measures based on the social audit report especially for Shrawasti.
- Take steps to increase attendance of children during summer vacation in drought hit districts.
- Issue circular to schools for presence of two parents every day during serving of mid day meal to monitor the quality of meals.

Puducherry

- UT of Puducherry assured to take necessary steps to enhance the coverage of children especially at Upper Primary stage.
- Food samples of Mid Day Meal would be tasted randomly to ascertain calorie content and also check biological and chemical contaminations from time to time.
- UT assured to roll out the automated monitoring system before the commencement of next session.
- Social audit will be carried in the UT as per the MHRD guidelines during the current financial year.

Lakshadweep

Uttarakhand

- To take appropriate measures to solve the problem of delay in release of MDM fund to schools.
- The State Govt. would take corrective measure to improve the coverage children in poor performing districts.
- Completion of construction of all sanctioned Kitchen cum stores by June 2016.
- e-Transfer of Honorarium to Cook cum Helpers working in remote area schools in their bank account.
- 60% schools to have LPG facility by June 2016.
- Food Sample Testing by accredited lab would be initiate during FY 2016-17.
- Ensured all children are covered under RBSK and IFA and deworming medicines are distributed

Uttarakhand.... conti

- To conduct Social Audit on pilot basis in few districts during 2016-17.
- Directions will be issued for testing meals by at least two parents besides of cook and teacher etc.
- Implementation of Tithi Bhojan in schools under MDMS throughout the State .
