


#### **Social Audit - MDMS**

"Social Audit" means the process in which people collectively monitor and evaluate the planning and implementation of a programme or scheme

# The people and the Government jointly monitors the scheme



Social audit is a democratic process to ensures public accountability through involvement of the community

- Social audit is an ongoing process of public vigilance.
- The twin objectives of this social intervention -
  - (1) create awareness among beneficiaries under the scheme
  - (2) empower them to hold Government accountable through monitoring of the MDMS.
- It ensures transparency, reduces leakages, forces proper spending of funds, generates trust and creates demand led improvement in delivery of services.

## National food security Act 2013

- Chapter XI- Transparency and accountability-section 28(1&2)- <u>Social Audit</u>
  - 28. (1) Every local authority, or any other authority or body, as may be authorized by the State Government, shall conduct or cause to be conducted, <u>periodic social audits</u> on the functioning of fair price shops, Targeted Public Distribution System and other welfare schemes, and cause to publicise its findings and take necessary action, in such manner as may be prescribed by the State Government.

• 28 (2) The Central Government may, if it considers necessary, conduct or cause to be conducted social audit through independent agencies having experience in conduct of such audits

#### **MHRD-Intervention**

- Social Audit on Pilot basis was conducted in Andhra Pradesh in 2012- 2013 in two districts and very encouraging findings came out.
- Since 2014-15 onwards MHRD advised all States to conduct social audit of MDMS on pilot basis and then scale up in all the districts in the State/UTs in phased manner.
