Preparing the AWP& B 2018-19

Precautions to be taken

- Write up portion should cover all the points.

 Proposed strategies/ intervention for 2018-19
- No. of institutions should not be double counted.
- Data on replacement of kitchen devices should match with earlier sanctions.
- Information on USB should match with the data provided by State/ UTs earlier through UCs.
- The relevant information should match with the data provided by States/ UTs through QPRs.

The write up portion consist of brief history, process of plan formulation, fund flow system, food grain management, system of payment of honorarium to cook-cum-helpers, best practices followed in the State, Grievance Redressal Mechanism, community participation, etc.

Strategy to enhance the coverage of children

- The States need to pay special attention on the districts where coverage of children under MDMS has been below the national average.
- The reasons for lesser coverage may be examined and accordingly suitable strategies to be chalked out for enhancing the coverage of children in schools.
- The district plan of the poor performing districts should include strategies for enhancing the coverage and to ensure effective implementation of the scheme.
