

Centralized Payment


Objectives:

- To utilize the maximum funds of the budget allocation.
- To save delay in payment of bills to the SHGs/NGOs.
- To minimize the work load of the MEOs.
- To maintain Transparency in making payment.
- To monitor the bill payments Centrally from the State.

Process of Centralized Payment

- The Govt.of AP have developed website with the assistance APCFSS (Andhra Pradesh Center for Finance Systems and Services). <u>https://apmdm.apcfss.in</u>
- In the First instance capturing the bank details of SHGs/NGOs through the website and mapped to the School UDISE.
- Login provided to all the MEOs to enter the daily attendance and Meals taken of the students.
- All the MEOs will confirm the claim of each school by the end of the month in the format given in the web portal.
- Inturn the DEOs concerned confirm the district claim under MDM



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- By the end of the month the attendance of all the Schools in the State have been consolidated and the bill will automatically generated in the format placed in the web site.
- The confirmation of bill process will be completed before 4th of the succeeding month
- The bill will be prepared on 5th of every moth and presented to Pay and Accounts office for releasing the bill amount to the SHGs.
- On the next day the amount will be credited in to the bank A/c of SHGs/NGOs.

Supply of Food-grains through e-pos system

Objectives:

- To avoid supply of underweight bags.
- To protect Transparency in supply.
- To supply the food-grains in-time



Process:

- The electronic point of sale is introduced in MDM to supply foodgrains during the year 2016 - 17 (www.scm.ap.gov.in)
- The AP Civil supplies dept., NIC and Education Dept., are coordinating with each other in implementing the scheme.
- At first instance, schools are mapped with the near by fair price shops.

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- Bio-metric system is developed by the Civil supply system with the school HM/SHG aadhar No. to lift the food-grains.
- Every month the indent is placed through online by the MEO in the portal of Civil supply Dept. "Supply chain system"
- Every month from 1st to 11th HMs/SHGs will lift the food-grains from the fair price shops.
- From 12th onwards the indent will be placed for next month supply of foodgrains.
- From 21st onwards food-grains will be transported from FCI to fair price shops.
- This systems is linked with CM's dash board of Andhra Pradesh, which is developed for monitoring of every scheme every day.
- With this system, we could overcome the problem of supply of less quantity of rice in the packed gunny bags.

State level Supply of Eggs to the Schools

Objectives:

- o To Provide Eggs thrice a week per child.
- To provide additional Nutritious food to the students.
- To maintain uniformity in providing food in all schools.

Process:

- The order given to the suppliers for supply of Eggs duly calling for the tenders.
- The Eggs weighing 45 to 52 grms are supplied.
- Eggs are supplied to the school point once in a week.
- To avoid supply of time barred Eggs, the Color stamp assign on the Eggs.
 - ✓ 1st week Yellow
 - ✓ 2nd week Blue
 - ✓ 3rd week Green
