

MANIPUR STATE

- Manipur is a <u>state</u> in northeastern <u>India</u>, with the city of <u>Imphal</u> as its capital. It is bounded by <u>Nagaland</u> to the north, <u>Mizoram</u> to the south, and <u>Assam</u> to the west; <u>Burma</u> lies to its east. The state covers an area of 22,327 square kilometres (8,621 sq mi). Its people include the Meetei, Kuki, Naga, Pangal, Gorkhali and Bishnupriya Manipuri, who speak different types of <u>Sino-Tibetan languages</u>.
- Manipur has a population of 2,721,756.

STEPS INITIATED BY THE STATE DURING FY 2014-15

- Flow of fund is streamlined and even able to release in advance after opening a dedicated account exclusively for MDM Scheme at the State Government level.
- Direct communication from State Authority to School Authority through SMS helped in streamlining the implementation.
- School Health Programme initiated in convergence with NRHM, Manipur. RBSK done during 14th to 19 Nov. 2014. No scope for providing free spectacles is seen in their budget till date.

Contd...

- Social Audit, License of the Kitchen Sheds under MDM and tasting of food samples are in the pipeline.
- Mobile based networking using tablets to achieve effective monitoring is introducing shortly.
- Issues associated with the Construction of KS has been sorted out and likely to complete in the near future.
- Capacity building of teachers is also in the line.

ISSUES AND CHALLENGES

- Food grain indent is always delayed by either 1 or 2 months at the District Collectors level.
- Funds released on cooking cost are parked for many months at District Collectors office.
- As per local market price, the required cooking cost for Primary is Rs. 7.00 against Rs. 3.59 and Rs. 12.50 against Rs. 5.38 in Upper Primary.
