



## STATUS OF SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMME

 Micro-nutrient, Vitamin A, De-worming, Iron and Folic Acid, Zinc and spectacles could be provided except the executive health check up in some schools.

 The Health & Medical Services Department (NRHM) have been requested to provide the needful and it is expected that the same will be provided to the students in the near future.



### CAPACITY BUILDING

- Capacity building and training on implementation of Mid-day Meal for sensitizing and objective of the scheme had been conducted in all the District Headquarters.
- Teachers, representatives of VEC and NGOs who are involved in Mid-Day Meal for the schools were imparted training. Resource Persons were provided by the department.
- Cooks were trained on sanitation, hygiene and safety measures at respective SDEO wise location.

### **CONTINGENCY/MEDICAL EMERGENCY PLAN**

 All schools under the respective SDEOs have the contact names and numbers (written on the menu board) of the nearest medical centres /staffs and subsequently have been strategized by the schools how to tackle the eventualities.

### **TESTING OF FOOD SAMPLES**

 Testing of food samples by State Food Laboratory, Kohima under the Department of Health and Family Welfare is on the pipeline for qualitative analysis in term of nutritional values, chemical contents, pesticide, bacteriology etc.



#### **ISSUES:**

- MME Small state having lesser budgetary provision,
   MME % may be enhanced to that of SSA as the total coverage is same with SSA.
- KITCHEN- Kitchen constructed with earlier sanctioned amount(Rs. 60,000/-) was too meager and could meet only the cost of CGI sheets and labour charges. The kitchens had to be constructed with locally available materials contributed by the community which are now in depilated condition and are not safe to store the MDM food items.
- Honorarium to Cooks Enhancement of honorarium to cook-cum- helpers from Rs. 1000/- to Rs. 2000/-
- \* Cooking cost Rs. 3.59 for Primary & Rs. 5.38 Upper Primary stages is not logistically practicable to serve MDM
- Pre- primary Coverage of pre-primary students under MDM scheme.
