Subject: Organization of Workshop/Orientation meeting with State Governments / Union Territory Administrations on 04-07-2017 at 10.30 am at IHC, New Delhi on – (i) Aadhaar Enrolment of Students, (ii) Proposal for balance of 1st instalment under MDMS and (iii) Other issues: Automated Monitoring System.

The undersigned is directed to say that 18 States/UTs under MDMS have percentage of Aadhaar enrolment of students (class I to VIII) above 80% while 15 States/UTs except Assam, Meghalaya & J&K have Aadhaar Enrolment of Students below 80%. States/UTs are required to submit Utilization Certificate in GFR Form 12-C as per GFR-2017. Most of the States/UTs have either submitted UC unsigned or not signed by the appropriate authority while submitting the proposal for release of balance of 1st instalment under MDMS. 27 States/UTs have implemented Automated Monitoring System (AMS) and started pushing the data in the Central Server of NIC on daily basis. 9 States/UTs namely, *Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, J&K, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal* have not yet rolled out AMS.

2. It has been decided to organize a orientation meeting/workshop on 4th July, 2017 at 10.30 am at IHC, New Delhi with all the States/UTs to discuss and review the issues mentioned above.

3. The workshop will enable the participating States/UTs –

(i) Aadhaar Enrolment

- to achieve 100% Aadhaar Enrolment of Students by 31st August, 2017.


(ii) Additional Issues

- to get Central Assistance under balance of 1st instalment by 15th July, 2017.
- to be conversant with objectives of AMS, on-boarding credentials, SMS based system structures with functioning, the features of the Mobile apps for posting the Data on NIC server and timely rolling out of AMS by 31st July, 2017 in the States where AMS have not yet implemented.

4. Government of India would bear the expenditure for organizing the above Workshop/Orientation meeting. However, the Expenditure of TA/DA/boarding & lodging of the participants will have to be borne by the respective State Governments / UT Administrations. Project Manager, TSG-MDM, EdCIL (India) Ltd. will be Nodal officer for organizing this meeting. Shri Sunil Sinha, Sr. Consultant, TSG-MDM would be the Nodal Consultant for this workshop.

5. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary / Secretary (Education) of the States/UTs are requested to nominate 2 officers who are well conversant with Aadhaar and AMS from their respective States/UTs (including Nodal Officer for AMS). The list of nomination from State Govt. may be sent to Project Manager, TSG-MDM, EdCIL (India) Ltd. at pmmmdmtsg@gmail.com and sinha.mdm@gmail.com under intimation to this Department by 30-06-2017. The nominated officer from the States/UTs should also bring the soft copy of Master data base including the Mobile Number of Teachers of their States where AMS have not yet implemented.
